RESOLUTION 2023-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF COWLITZ 911 PUBLIC AUTHORITY APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO A PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY AND ADCOMM ENGINEERING, LLC, DATED THE 9TH DAY OF JUNE 2021.

WHEREAS, on or about June 9th, 2021, the COWLITZ 911 PUBLIC AUTHORITY, as authorized by RCW 35.21.730 through RCW 35.21.759 (hereinafter "COWLITZ 911") and ADCOMM Engineering, LLC, an Oregon Limited Liability Company (hereinafter "ADCOMM"), entered into a Personal Services Agreement, with the overarching goal of the project being for ADCOMM to lead the planning and coordination with entities necessary to support the transition of technology equipment from the existing Admin (backup center) and Hall of Justice (primary center) to the new Ocean Beach (OB) 9-1-1 facility; and

WHEREAS, through no fault of the parties and due to the global pandemic known as "COVID-19" and its many variants and to the uncertainty arising from the nature of the pandemic, the parties agree that, through an Act of God, it was not possible to complete the project by June 30, 2022 as stated in the above personal services agreement; and

WHEREAS, through no fault of the parties, ADCOMM incurred additional costs and expenses to complete the project as the parties had originally agreed that were unforeseen by the parties but needed to be overcome in order for COWLITZ 911 to achieve the planning and coordination required by COWLITZ 911; and

WHEREAS, through negotiations between the parties, with legal counsel as they may have required, the parties now agree that the originally agreed total cost of \$600,980 for the above said services was insufficient for the work actually performed and should be compensated in an additional amount payment of \$210,260 by COWLITZ 911 to ADCOMM; and

WHEREAS, ADCOMM agrees that with this final payment of \$210,260, it will be fully compensated for the work done and waives any and all claims it might have had or asserted against COWLITZ 911 due to all works performed by ADCOMM or could now be claimed by ADCOMM.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the parties

- 1. That the term of the June 9, 2021, for completion of the work here is hereby extended, by the mutual agreement of the parties, until December 30th, 2023.
- 2. That the total costs of the services provided by ADCOMM is increased by an additional \$210,260 overly the additional agreed price of \$600,980, for a new total price of the services of \$811,240 to be made in monthly payments until all the work agreed by the parties is completed, in a satisfactory manner, no later than December 30, 2023.
- 3. The parties further agree that the extent and character of all work and services performed under said Agreement by the Contractor ADCOMM shall be subject to the review and approval of the COWLITZ 911 P.A. Executive Director or designee. And for purposes of this amended agreement, the COWLITZ 911 P.A. Executive Director is:
