We hope that all our New Zealand friends and fellow breeders all across the country are well and are enjoying the summer. All is well here as we await the arrival, in mid August, of daughters and grandkids from NY and Chicago. It's city kids coming to the country- BB guns and playing in the creek and probably catching poison oak. I can guarantee that the boys will pressure me to let them graduate from BB guns to the 22.

Here, in our part of northern California we have had a warm but not unduly hot summer. There have been several days in the mid 90s but nothing over 100. The evenings and mornings, even when it is in the 90s during the day, are cool to cold. Warm days and cool evenings is what makes our area a premium wine grape growing region. Other areas have not been as fortunate with the hot weather. Many breeders have lost rabbits.

Our good friend Roger Wood tells me that our central valley, Fresno area, has experienced over 19 consecutive days of over 100 degree weather.

There has been an exceedingly high demand for meat pen rabbits this year. It appears that because of the bad economy many 4H and FFA youth have down sized their projects from large animals to small ones like poultry and rabbits. New Zealand pens continue to improve and do well in an area long dominated by Californians. A NZ pen won grand champion at the El Dorado County Fair. The Sonoma County Fair, in Santa Rosa, is one of the biggest and most important in California. Cals have tended to dominate since there are three nationally known Cal breeders in our area. This year, in very tough competition, Theresa Hinrichs of Cloverdale won the Supreme Grand Champion pen with New Zealand Whites.

It has been rough going with the ARBA Standard Committee on the changes to the New Zealand Standard. At this point in the process, some of the changes have been accepted but many of the more substantial ones that we voted on have been rejected.

We are beginning to think about and prepare for the San Diego convention. We'll have excellent judges. The New Zealand banquet is a Fajita

Buffet that will be held at Chevys FRESH MEX Restaurant, just across the freeway from Del Mar. Details about the banquet are provided in another section of the Times as well as on the federation website.

San Diego is a beautiful city. The temperature is always mild. There are many world- class attractions. The San Diego Zoo in Balboa Park is a must. If you like lobster, consider taking the tour to Puerto Nuevo, a small fishing village on the Mexican coast famous for it's many lobster restaurants.

For a change, we won't have to spend a lot of money flying with the rabbits to the convention. Still it will be a long drive- at least 10 hours. 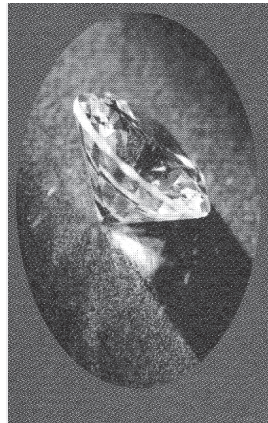

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IS YOUR RABBITRY PROPERLY VENTILATED?

Properly ventilated rabbitries will enhance health, growth, reproduction and overall condition of rabbits. Conversely, rabbitries that are not properly ventilated will cause deterioration of the aforementioned traits.

The temperature for optimum rabbit performance is about 55 degrees Fahrenheit. Summer heat stress is a severe problem with rabbits. Continuous exposure to temperatures greater than 85 degrees Fahrenheit for 4-5 days can cause sterility for up to 60 days in mature bucks (bucks usually older than one year). All rabbits are vulnerable to heat prostration when cage temperatures exceed 92 degrees Fahrenheit.

During the winter, naturally ventilated housing is adequate for mature rabbits provided there are no drafts. Supplemental heat can minimize frozen water, water lines and maintain growth & performance.

Relative humidity below 35 % dries the respiratory tract which can lead to respiratory problems (i.e. Snuffles). The same issues can occur when humidity levels exceed 65 % where too much moisture is present in the air.

Insulating walls and roofs of buildings will reduce or moderate summer temperatures in the building and reduce winter supplemental heat loss. Insulating roofs of outside structures can also help to moderate the affect of summer heat on rabbits.

A healthy air environment in the rabbitry can only be achieved through proper ventilation. Maintaining a healthy air environment in a building is more difficult verse an outside structure (hutch and/or open front shed).

Manure buildup as well as excessive hair on cages will reduce air quality and airflow. Removing manure and excessive hair in the rabbitry is critical to maintaining a healthy air environment.

So where does one go to find out:

What size fan do I need?

How many fans do I need?

What type of fan is best?

Where do I locate the fans?

What other types of devices are available?

What size building is best for natural ventilation?

How much air do I need to move through the building?



The answer to these questions and others relevant to ventilation can be found through the Midwest Plan Service. The Midwest Plan Service contains detailed ventilation publications with information for rabbits! YES I SAID RABBITS!!!!!! You can access these for sale publications on-line at www.mwps.org. Or contact your local extension office as many of these offices have the publications on hand and can provide you with the information.

Properly ventilated rabbitries are synonymous with successful breeding and show stock programs. Ask your self this question, is the air they are breathing the air you want to breathe? Ventilation provides fresh air and fresh air is what a bunny needs.

Ray E. Bradway

March 16, 1925 - August 24, 2009

Ray, 84, from Sharpsville, IN passed away Monday, Aug. 24, 2009, at Howard Regional Health System. He was born March 16, 1925, in Fulton County, to Chester and Mary Ellen (Clevenger) Bradway. On March 14, 1958, in Leadhill, Ark., he married Margaret A. Donovan.

He graduated from Akron High School and then went on to serve in the U.S. Marine Corps during World War II. He began raising and caring for rabbits at an early age which turned into a lifelong hobby and led him to be involved in many groups and organizations. He was a judge and registrar for the American Rabbit Breeders Association, one of the founding members of Mid-Counties Rabbit Breeders Association, and a member of the Indiana State Rabbit Breeders Association. He was active in promoting 4-H rabbit programs and was a judge at many of the fairs, including the Indiana State Fair.

A Dose of Information

*I had a junior buck disqualified for spilt penis.
What do you know about this condition?*

Spilt penis is a condition where the bottom part of the penile shaft does not close. This is a form of hermaphroditism. When the buck breeds, he may not get the doe pregnant as the sperm may not make it into her. We do feel the condition is hereditary.

I see this condition the most in small breeds, with the Holland Lop and the Mini Rex most often. I have not seen a New Zealand with this condition. It is picked up most easily in bucks which are quite sexually active, as the spit penis is straight out for all to see. Our New Zealands are generally a little more reserved.

A spilt penis really needs to be spilt entirely down the shaft, from the tip to the base to really be a spit penis. I have seen bucks with a slit that is $\frac{1}{4}$ the length of the penis and feel this is normal. Remember that rabbits have a lot of crystals in their urine, so the opening to the urinary tract must be wide enough to allow these to pass. This small slit is noticeable in New Zealands and should not be mistaken for a true spilt penis.

This brings us to that junior buck. I have described the penis in an immature buck, as a

“volcano.” When you properly expose the penis of a 2 month old New Zealand buck, you will see it as a round mound with a hole in the center, i.e. a “volcano.” The junior doe will have a slit. If you do not properly expose the penis of the young buck, you will think he is a doe. So be sure you press hard enough to get his organ to extend fully.

Around 4 months of age, the bucks go through puberty where that volcano turns into a pencil point of the mature buck. At this time, the buck can look like he has a split penis. If you will wait another 2 weeks, the change will be completed, and he no longer has the spilt penis.

A true spilt penis buck will be sexed as a doe when he is a junior. Then as he reaches puberty, his penis elongates and his testicles will drop. Any rabbit with a successful show career as a junior doe, who later is determined to be a buck when his testicles drop, should be carefully examined for a spilt penis. There is a nice picture of a spilt penis on page 52 of the Standard of Perfection. But I would like to caution anyone looking at this picture, that if this is a 4 month old buck, he may be going through puberty as that penis is not as long as I would expect in a fully developed senior. As a judge, I would disqualify a rabbit which looked like the picture on page 52. But, if it was a junior, I would have the breeder wait another month just to be sure.

Sam judged all rabbits with a fair non political position that all judges could copy. If Sam judged your rabbits at a show, whatever the breed, you could count on his fair analysis with no personal agenda. The standard of the breed is what he based his judging decisions. You might not agree with his opinion all the time but you knew he was not favoring a person, but judging the rabbit that day. Sam loved to travel with his judging and was still attending shows into May of this year.

Sam was a member and leader of many rabbit organizations. The one thing you could count on with Sam was that he was a worker and contributed any and all of his rabbit knowledge to that club. When our federation was in desperate

need of a secretary a few years ago, Sam's name was brought up. When Sam was asked if he could help the club out and serve as our secretary, there was no hesitation on his part. He just asked how soon he needed to start. When I decided to serve the club as it's president, the fact that Sam was the secretary at that time made my decision for me. I knew I could work with Sam and we would try and keep the club the solid organization it already was. Sam was the club's solid foundation and I was blessed to be able to work with him.

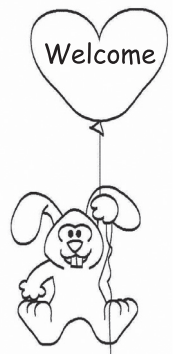

Do's & Don'ts of Showing

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Long Island RBA Bunny Hutch News



The Do's of Showing

1. Check the weather the night before the show so that you'll know whether or not to bring anything extra for the rabbits, yourself, or your car.

2. Bring a copy of the entry form. If there's a mistake in the pre-entry show, you can straighten it out more easily if you have the entry form. For entries on the day of show, bring a list of the rabbits you're going to show and the ear number of each so that you can fill out the forms faster.

3. Get to the show in plenty of time before it starts so that you aren't rushed. Your rabbits can feel your tension and will react, IMO.

4. Bring some kind of treat for your rabbits to munch on. Even though most people won't become distressed at the new surroundings, your rabbits might. They'd probably enjoy a hay cube, some grass hay, or a slice of apple or carrot, and it would help reduce their stress. Be sure to bring something for them to drink from, too.

5. Try to get a good night's sleep. Rest can be the difference between having a good show day for yourself and a day that you can barely squint through. No sense in putting you or your animals at risk from a bad night's sleep. If you have to, take a cat nap after your breeds are judged so that you can drive home safely.

6. Bring an extra empty carrier for that unexpected purchase. It's better to bring an extra empty hole than to try to squeeze two rabbits in one hole. Think safety.

7. Have a first-aid kit and your grooming kit. It's better to have the kits on hand and not use them, than to have an emergency pop up and be lost without them. 8. Above all, remember that it's not what you win but how you win it. Please be a gracious winner and a gracious loser. We all win and lose from one show to the next. Nobody's perfect.



The Don'ts of Showing

1. Don't get mad and start bad-mouthing the judge just because you didn't win. Remember, he/she is just a person who's giving an opinion of your animal on that given day.

2. Don't bad-mouth a rabbit that the judge is judging. In other words, don't point out something that you see and the judge doesn't. Most people would look at this as trying to sway the judge's opinion or as cheating. Remember, you're not the one that holds the judging license.

3. Don't forget your tattoo kit for those tattoos that always seem to disappear at the wrong time.

4. Don't let the judge know which animal is yours. For instance, don't say to the judge, "Remember when you gave this doe a BOB (Best of Show) when she was only four months old? Look at her now." If you do this, you could have your entire entry DQ'ed (disqualified) from the show. I know that this sounds crazy, but I've seen it happen more than once.

5. Don't fake your rabbit. This simply means do not alter the appearance of your rabbit by plucking stray white hairs, putting anything on the toenails to make them match or to make darker, etc. If you're caught, it means the disqualification of your entire entry at the show.

6. Don't blame anyone if you miss the judging for your class of rabbits. You need to pay attention to when and where the judging is for your breed. Listen to announcements of breeds being called. If you can't hear, go and ask repeatedly what breed is up. Remember, missing your class is a bummer, but it's not the end of the world.

7. Don't be a poor sport. Winning at all costs isn't a desirable trait when it comes to show people.

8. Above all, don't bring an animal to the show that's sick. It isn't fair to the other owners or their rabbits. You'd be pretty upset if someone caused your healthy rabbits to get sick or if you lost one due to the illness.

Attend a Show.....Meet People.....Have Fun.....Rabbits are Cool !!

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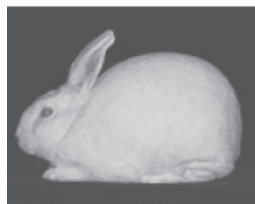

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Following is the “New” Guidelines for selecting Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex of Breed at the New Zealand National Show and the ARBA Convention Show. If you have any questions regarding the procedure, please contact one of the club Officers or Directors.

Selection of Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex

Goals:

- 1 - Each Judge making class placements will have a decision in the selection of BOB and BOS New Zealand.
- 2 - Each Judge will make his or her decision individually.
- 3 - Eliminate the chances of ties in the selection process.
- 4 - Each variety of New Zealands have equal chance of being selected for BOB or BOS New Zealand.

Recommended Procedures:

- 1 - Each Judge that makes class placings will individually select their top three (3) animals from the Preciously selected Best of Varieties.
- 2 - In making their individual picks, the following point system will apply to their choices: 1st selection - 5 points, 2nd selection - 3 points, 3rd selection - 1 point.
- 3 - Each Judge will make their selection individually. They will then record their three (3) selections in order 1 thru 3 on forms and give to the show secretary. The process will be repeated until each Judge makes their individual selections. When Judges are not making their selections, they will be asked to leave the judging area until the winners are announced by the show secretary after each Judge has selected their animals for Best of Breed New Zealand.
- 4 - The show secretary will total the votes for each animal, the Best of Variety animal with the highest point total will be the BOB New Zealand. In the event of a tie, the animal with the lowest total will be removed and the selection by the Judges will be repeated.
- 5 - Following the selection of the Best of Breed, the Best of Variety or Best Opposite Sex Variety of the opposite sex of the selected Best of Breed will be brought up for the selection by each of the Judges for Best Opposite Sex of Breed. The same individual selection process by the Judges will take place for the selection of Best Opposite Sex of Breed.
- 6 - Open and Youth divisions will both use the same process. Judges will only make selections in the divisions they judged, Open or Youth.
