I am going to be appointing a special committee to look into our current ballot system when choosing judges for BOV and BOB. Vice Presidents Message— Bob Swartz

I have judging commitments all through the month of April, so will not be attending the National New Zealand Show in Belton, Texas on April 5. This gets to be a problem when you are bidding shows two or three years in advance. I don't think it is right to cancel a show when you have given your word that you will be there to judge. This has happened to our local club a time or two and it is very difficult to find replacement judges at the last minute. It also sours a club on using a judge again that cancels out on them except for an emergency situation. When a judge cancels out, he or she runs the risk of not being hired by a club in the future. As a rabbit judge we need to keep our judging priorities straight.

This has been a tough month in Ohio to raise rabbits, frozen water bowls being normal all

through January and February. I still raise all of my rabbits outside and sometimes wonder at the sanity of it all! Of course after a few early spring days it all goes away and we forget about the bad times we had during the winter months. It's amazing how well the rabbits adapt to winter conditions. They soon learn to drink water before it freezes. I water at least twice a day and they quickly drink there fill. They seem to need more water when consuming feed. I normally go through and feed all of the rabbits and then come back about a half hour later and water for the last time of the day. Most of them are ready for a drink. I seldom have any feed left in there crocks/feeders the next day. Most of the rabbits come through the winter in pretty good condition and many raise nice litters on the limited

amount of water. They don't seem to require nearly as much water in the winter as they do in hot weather.

This is the slow time of the year in our area concerning rabbits. I've only talked to a few rabbit breeders during December and January. The Ohio show season gets under way in February. There is a show the first Sunday in February and a show the last Sunday in February. Attendance at these shows depends on weather and road conditions. They usually come out all right, but once in awhile they take a hit. Once we get to March there is a show just about every weekend. This keeps all Ohio rabbit breeders busy.

April 5th if you can! The Texas New Zealand Breeders have been working hard and are well prepared. Good luck to all attending! Bob Swartz

Directors Reports

Director Manuel Hidalgo, California

Linda and I hope that everyone had a wonderful holiday season and have started off the New Year in the best of health and with many good resolutions. We had an enjoyable holiday with lots of kids and grandkids. It was fun, but after it's all said and done it was good to get the house back to ourselves.

It has been unusually cold here in northern California with temperatures running about 10 degrees below normal. We complain about the cold but deep down we know that low 40s during the day and mid 20s at night is actually not bad when compared to what many of you have to face in other parts of the country. Thankfully, we have had above normal rainfall, so far, after enduring two years of drought.

The show season starts here, in California, in early January. As of January 26th I have already judged two shows and have three scheduled for February. Our club show, The Sonoma/Marin Rabbit Association's January Jamboree was held in Santa Rosa on January 19th and had more than 3300 entries.

Directors Reports

Director Dean Benker, Minnesota

I just received my semimonthly call from Adam that he has everyone else's articles but mine, so here goes. I will take this opportunity to complain about the frozen tundra this year. Since Dec. 2 it has been one of the coldest winters in many years. So far we have had 56 days with a HIGH below 32 degrees, average is 24 days. A couple of weeks ago it was 44 degrees and raining, 24 hours later -20 with a wind chill of -44. I cringe every time I check the propane tank for the barn, so far two fillings.

The rabbits have been doing well, have had the best winter breeding numbers ever, I guess they don't know what is going on outside. One good thing about a cold winter like this, you learn a foreign language after about three slips on the ice.

I am sure everyone is looking forward to the nationals in Texas, why couldn't they be in Feb.? I am afraid we will use our fuel budget on propane and not fuel to go to Texas. I am sure they will put on a good show and the breed will be well represented. It is time to be breeding for the 6/8's and Sr's for Louisville. That should also be a great show with the usual strong competition.

I was very pleased to see the positive vote of the federation for acceptance of the Brokens. Again, way to go Dave! Hope this finds everyone healthy and with full nest boxes.

Director David Klindt, Iowa

Hopefully everyone is getting through the long cold days of winter ok. Here in Iowa the weather has been anywhere from -20 to 60 degrees. We've had lots of snow and ice this winter and it seems like we get one bitter cold week followed by a warmer week. Anyway each week that passes is one week closer to spring.

As February has started now it time to start showing rabbits again. February and March are big months for showing rabbits in Iowa and Illinois. If you want to I think you can almost show every week. It won't be long now and we'll be sending are entries in for the spring show in Belton Texas. I realize this is a long drive for a lot of people but hopefully we can get a nice turnout of rabbits

bits down there. Also it time to be breeding rabbits for 6-8's for the convention in Louisville this fall. Good luck and we'll see you in Belton.

Director Al Esterline, Indiana

Kindling in northern Indiana where temperatures go down to 0' F many nights during the winter can be a real problem. I have not gotten to the point where I can breed the doe's so that they will kindle on warm days.

I am not going to cover every aspect of kindling, I am going to talk about some things that work for me. I do have a heated kindling building, but that does not solve all problems. During kindling periods I try to keep the temps around 55'F and during non kindling times 40'F, or enough heat to keep crocks from freezing. I do have a problem with ventilation and ammonia if I raise the temperature too high. When I was our county 4-H rabbit club leader, the 4-Her's juniors needed to be born in Jan.& Feb. I designed a plywood box, 24"X30" and 2 feet high. This box could be put in a warm place, like the garage or a laundry room, just put shavings in it. This ideal will also work well for first time doe's, because they can build a nest any place they want to. I use the box recently where I had a doe urinate all over her one week old babies. I figured she became upset for some reason. The babies were wet, cold, all stretched out and crying. I took them in the house not expecting to save any of them, gave them to my wife to dry, and warm them up.

I put a plywood box in the basement, where it is warm. Then shavings were put in the box and a nest made in the corner with fur from my fur bag. I put the babies in the nest, then the doe in the box. One week later, everyone is doing well. Once the nest has served its purpose we save all the remains and my wife uses it for mulch around her flower beds.

Meat Pens—Manuel Hidalgo

Raising a successful rabbit meat pen entry requires hard work, good luck and meticulous feeding, posing and grooming. It is critical to start with the best quality stock that you can find, with good type, firm flesh and good fur. When making your mating, always breed for compensating strengths and weaknesses in the buck and doe. This means that you should not breed two rabbits with the same fault, like weak shoulders or a weak rear-end.

CRITERIA

A meat pen consists of three (3) rabbits of the same breed and variety. They do not have to come from the same litter.

The minimum weight is three (3) pounds each and the maximum weight is five (5) pounds each.

Age limit is 70 days (10 weeks).

All rabbits must be weighed in the presence of the judge.

NEW ZEALAND MEAT PEN STRATEGY AND BREEDING

In tough competition, the closer the pen is to 5 pounds each the better chance it has of winning.

A New Zealand pen at 10 weeks will certainly be over 5 pounds. Ideally a NZ pen should be between 8.5 and 9 weeks old.

Breed the doe 90-94 days before weigh-in. Start checking the doe for receptiveness about 95 days before the show. A dark pink, red or purple vulva almost guarantees conception. Light/medium pink is iffy. A doe with a very light pink/ grey vulva will almost never conceive.

Does are more likely to accept the buck when they currently have a litter on them.

They are also more likely to conceive when re-bred in multiples of seven (7) days after the birth of the litter. This means, try to re-breed the doe when the babies are: 7, 14, 21, 28, 35, 42, 49, or 56, etc., days old. Most old-time New Zealand breeders used a 42 day breed back schedule.

Breed the doe and then re-breed her one hour later. Retest the breeding 3 days later.

If you purchase your meat pen, make sure that there is no more than a 2oz. difference between the rabbits. A 2oz. difference at 4 weeks can mean an 8oz. (or more) difference between the rabbits at 8+ weeks.

It is also cheap insurance and a good practice to purchase an extra rabbit (starting your pen project with a total of 4 rabbits). This allows you to take the best 3 to the show and provides insurance in the case that one dies or goes off feed.

FEED AND WATER

Free feed a blend of your regular herd feed (16%) and a show feed like **Purina Show** or **Mana Pro Sho**. Don't overfill feeder; keep feed fresh.

Feed 2 to 3 ounces of whole or rolled oats each day. No hot grains!

Feed a good handful of hay 2-3 times a week or a little every-day.

Put electrolytes like **Aqua Vite** or **VITAL** in the water @ ½-1 tsp per gallon.

Starting at 6+ weeks of age the rate of gain is about 3oz every 2 days. If rabbits are getting too close to top weight cut back feed slightly to slow down the rate of gain or to maintain the existing weight. If pen is not gaining fast enough (like because of a big litter) switch to a doe and litter/family ration (higher protein 17-18%).

In order to minimize stress on the pen, one should take their own feed and water, with electrolytes, to the show/fair.

GROOMING AND PREPARATION

Once the rabbits are old enough and eating well, they should be handled and groomed with slightly dampened hands and posed regularly on a piece of carpet.

At 6-7 weeks start weighing the rabbits regularly (every few days) and group and pose them in matched pens of three (3). Having a good, accurate scale is essential. Keep track of the pen groupings with a Sharpie pen- mark in the right ear.

When you have made your final decision on the pen (based on uniformity of type, weight and condition) tattoo the rabbits in the left ear a few days before the show/fair.

This will be the petition, I am working on making it a file, but it will be here!

Brokens Pass! - Dave Mangione

Broken variety New Zealands pass with a splash. An overwhelming vote in favor of the broken variety by our membership is now official. The membership voted 139 in favor and 29 against the acceptance of the broken variety. It is great to have a large number of members voting on this history changing event in our breed.

So what does this vote mean? Well, the broken variety can now move forward to the second presentation at the ARBA convention in Louisville, Ky. Dave Mangione will have to present 8 rabbits (senior pair, 6-8 pair, and junior pair). Assuming the second presentation passes, Dave will have a third and hopefully final presentation during the ARBA convention in San Diego, California. If everything goes as planned, the broken variety would be officially accepted into the standard following the 2009 ARBA convention and then the broken variety will be allowed to compete for BOB & BOS in all shows!

When can breeders start showing broken variety New Zealands at local shows as well as the New Zealand National and ARBA conventions? Once the working standard is published in the 2008 March/April issue of the Domestic Rabbit magazine we are good to go. In other words breeders can show broken varieties at local shows, Nationals, ARBA conventions. Breeders must present a **copy of the official breed/Variety working standard at time of judging or they will not be judged**. Local shows cannot turn down the showing of the broken variety as long as the working standard is presented. The other important point to remember is that the broken variety cannot compete for Best of Breed or Best opposite Sex of Breed, points or other awards until the variety has passed all presentation requirements set forth by the ARBA standards committee. The soonest this will happen assuming all goes well with the next two presentations is after the 2009 ARBA convention. So our National Show scheduled in Ohio the spring of 2010 will be the first major events to have brokens compete for BOB & BOS honors.

Now it is important for breeders to exhibit their broken variety and show everyone how widespread the interest is in this new variety!!!!

I want to thank all the breeders who have supported this endeavor to develop the broken variety New Zealand. It has been a long journey from the first mating, six years ago and there is still much to do over the next two years. But with your continued support we can make history and strengthen our position as the breed in the lead.
