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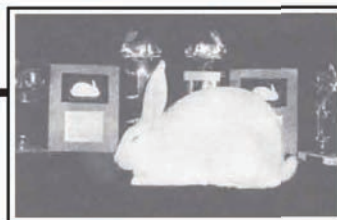

Teddy will be missed by those of us that knew him. (He had just won BIS at the 2010 Missouri State Fair when this picture was taken).



Teddy Dixon, 74, passed away suddenly from a stroke on May 15, 2011 at Davis County Hospital in Bloomfield, IA. Teddy was a lifetime member of both the ARBA (since 1962) and the New Zealand Rabbit Breeders Association. He raised and showed New Zealand Whites and Dutch rabbits earning many ribbons, trophies, and plaques over the years at both the local and state levels in Missouri & Iowa. He volunteered his time judging local 4-H fairs in Iowa, Illinois, and Missouri and helped many young people get their start in raising rabbits. He was known by many for his love of the hobby and his cheerful, generous spirit. He was known for bringing his own farm-produced honey to rabbit shows for his friends to enjoy.

Ted had a love for the outdoors and worked for the Soil Conservation Service of NE Missouri and the U.S. Forestry Service of Poplar Bluff, MO and was honored for 30+ years of service. He later retired to the family farm in Iowa overseeing its operation and continuing the hobby he enjoyed so much. As well as producing and selling honey, Ted also made walnut furniture using lumber from his own farm and sold the nuts his trees produced. He also enjoyed for many years being actively involved in the local Farm Bureau Agency as well as being a District Representative in Des Moines. He was a fan of Southern Gospel Quartet Music and traveled far and wide to enjoy many a concert and the annual Southern Gospel Quartet Convention in Louisville, Ky. He was a faithful and active member of Bible Baptist Church, in Ottumwa, IA. He loved life and his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Ted is survived by his wife, Josephine Dixon, of 55 years and his two children Kim (Clint) Neal of Quincy, IL and Cletus (Jody) Dixon of Laurel, IA. "PaPa's" big smile and warm hugs will also be dearly missed by his four grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. He will be sorely missed.

ENCOURAGING OUR YOUTH

As with all accomplishments in our lives there lies the undisputable truth that our legacy must be passed on. We as rabbit breeders work so hard to study the genetics for just the right breeding, the best conditioning, best grooming techniques for the ultimate purpose of producing "show winning rabbits". It takes years of dedication and hard work. Who are we going to pass this information on to? You might make the difference in a young kid's life by helping them become the best rabbit breeder they can be. Mentoring a youth and helping them enjoy our hobby as much as we do is a very fulfilling endeavor. They can win competitions that can help pay for college and trade schools. Sure, they may stray away from the hobby while going to college but, they may come back and become judges or breeders in the future. All we can do is encourage them in the best way we can by imparting the knowledge that we have to them.

Our kids started to show before my husband and I did. Now most of our kids are grown and in college and Pete and I show New Zealand whites and brokens in the open. It has been a long journey with our kids showing pigs, turkeys, broilers, goats, and rabbits. Now, all we do is rabbits. Three of our four kids showed through 4-H and FFA to get college monies and scholarships. It brought our family closer together and provided good work ethics to our kids.

I am the President of an all breed club near Houston, Texas. Texas has many kids who show meat pens in their local fairs and rodeos. Our club puts on a workshop to teach kids how to raise meat pens. We have it in the early fall right after school starts. Each year our attendance increases. Last year we had over 60 kids plus their parents. Not only do we talk about the commercial breeds but many of the fancy breeds as well. Our club members bring their rabbits up for the kids to hold and pet. It is a "hands on experience". Many of these kids never have the opportunity to see all the different breeds of rabbits and get a kick out of it. We have information in a booklet which we provide about diseases, husbandry, choosing breed stock, disqualifications in judging, etc. We also give out rabbit related door prizes which our club provides. It is very gratifying when the kids ask raise their hands and asks questions. That is when you know that they are interested.

I encourage you to help the kids in your area learn about our hobby. You never know what kind of influence you may have on their lives. The best pictures for me to use are those taken with digital cameras of 3 mega pixels or higher. I would simply as that if you have a number of pictures you wish to submit, please send only 1 or 2 per email (if submitting them electronically). With the higher mega pixel cameras, the size of some of the pictures is very large. My email server only allows me so much space in my "In Box", so if I am unable to download the pictures right away, the box has a tendency to become full, and emails are then returned.

If you receive a message that an email to me is being returned due to the box being full, please try to resend the pictures again at a later time, after I have had a chance to empty my box. I try to do this several times a day, but if I am out doing something in my "real life", I may not get to it for a day. Especially if I am off judging someplace for a day or weekend.

If you have a lot of pictures you wish to send, it is much easier on this end if you can drop them all on a CD or flash drive and send it to me via conventional mail. You are welcome to also just pull the memory card out of your camera (if that is how you have the pictures stored) and send that to me. I am happy to return any media type that you send to me if you want it back. I am able to read and download pictures from just about any type of storage vessel.

I do several National Specialty Club magazines, and I must say that the advertisements in the Times far outweigh any of the other clubs. The AFNZRB membership takes advantage of the magazine to advertise, and hopefully the results are rewarding. Considering the exposure, the cost of an ad is very reasonable. 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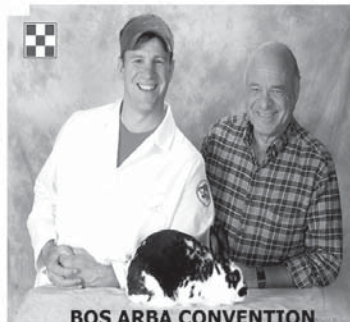

My Pro's & Con's Of Nest Box Bedding

Using the phrase of my good friend Donnie Hornback. In search or pursuit of the perfect rabbit. I'm kinda like that with nest box bedding. I keep looking for the perfect bedding material. We all use different types of materials for this purpose. Wood shavings (pine-aspen) straw, grasses (wheat-orchard) hay (timothy-alfalfa) coconut fibers, chopped corn cobs, shredded paper, wood pulp and even man made fiber mesh. The two most commonly used are probably wood shavings and straw. Here's a few pro's and con's I have experienced with each one.

(PRO'S) Wood shavings make a soft warm insulated nest. The way it packs down makes for a good dense layer which keeps the cold out. It absorbs moisture and odor well. Easy removal from nest box when cleaning. Used shavings can be spread over wet or damp areas in your rabbitry. Widely available to purchase at pet and farm supply stores. Coming tightly compressed from manufacturer makes for easy storage and space. Has a endless shelf life and reasonably priced.

(CON'S) As the young grow and move around more they tend to pulverize the bedding making it more like sawdust which may or may not cause respiratory problems for them. In sawdust form it packs tighter which makes it not dry out as quick. It stays damp longer which makes a ideal place for bacteria to grow.

(PRO'S) Straw makes a nice dry nest. Its good at absorbing moisture. Being hollow it dries out quicker and doesn't stay damp as long. It also makes for easy nest box cleaning. Fairly easy to find at plant nurseries or from local farmers. Storage life is good. One of the delights of using straw to me is watching the doe make her nest with it. Jumping in and out of the box with a mouth full of straw. Seems to make them happy.

(CON'S) Some bales of straw could be infested with fur mites according to my local veterinarian. They live inside the hollow blades. You will have to replenish it more often. Seems like they eat half of what you put in. It makes manure harder to shovel up. A little messy during storage unless kept in containers or large garbage bags. Left loose mice tend to make their homes in it.

Sometimes no matter which type of bedding we use or how hard you try to keep your boxes clean every so often one or two babies will end up with nest box eye which is very disheartening. I like to use a mixture of both shavings and straw myself. If any one has any good info or suggestions on this topic give me a call or better yet put it in the NZ TIMES so we all can gain a little knowledge. Whichever type you prefer keep those babies warm and dry.

Is Your Rabbitry Properly Ventilated?

Properly ventilated rabbitries will enhance health, growth, reproduction and overall condition of rabbits. Conversely, rabbitries that are not properly ventilated will cause deterioration of the aforementioned traits.

The temperature for optimum rabbit performance is about 55 degrees Fahrenheit. Summer heat stress is a severe problem with rabbits. Continuous exposure to temperatures greater than 85 degrees Fahrenheit for 4-5 days can cause sterility for up to 60 days in mature bucks (bucks usually older than one year). All rabbits are vulnerable to heat prostration when cage temperatures exceed 92 degrees Fahrenheit.

During the winter, naturally ventilated housing is adequate for mature rabbits provided there are no drafts. Supplemental heat can minimize frozen water, water lines and maintain growth & performance.

Relative humidity below 35 % dries the respiratory tract which can lead to respiratory problems (i.e. Snuffles). The same issues can occur when humidity levels exceed 65 % where too much moisture is present in the air.

Insulating walls and roofs of buildings will reduce or moderate summer temperatures in the building and reduce winter supplemental heat loss. Insulating roofs of outside structures can also help to moderate the affect of summer heat on rabbits.

A healthy air environment in the rabbitry can only be achieved through proper ventilation. Maintaining a healthy air environment in a building is more difficult verse an outside structure (hutch and/or open front shed).

Manure buildup as well as excessive hair on cages will reduce air quality and airflow. Removing manure and excessive hair in the rabbitry is critical to maintaining a healthy air environment.

So where does one go to find out:

What size fan do I need?

How many fans do I need?

What type of fan is best?

Where do I locate the fans?

What other types of devices are available?

What size building is best for natural ventilation?

How much air do I need to move through the building?



The answer to these questions and others relevant to ventilation can be found through the Midwest Plan Service. The Midwest Plan Service contains detailed ventilation publications with information for rabbits! YES I SAID RABBITS!!!!!! You can access these for sale publications on-line at www.mwps.org.

Properly ventilated rabbitries are synonymous with successful breeding and show stock programs. Ask your self this question, is the air they are breathing the air you want to breathe? Ventilation provides fresh air and fresh air is what a bunny needs.

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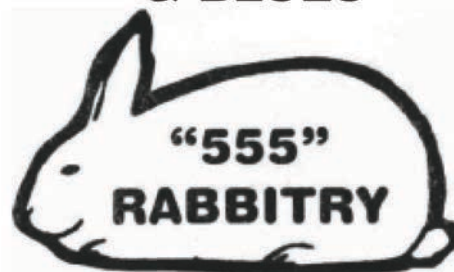
