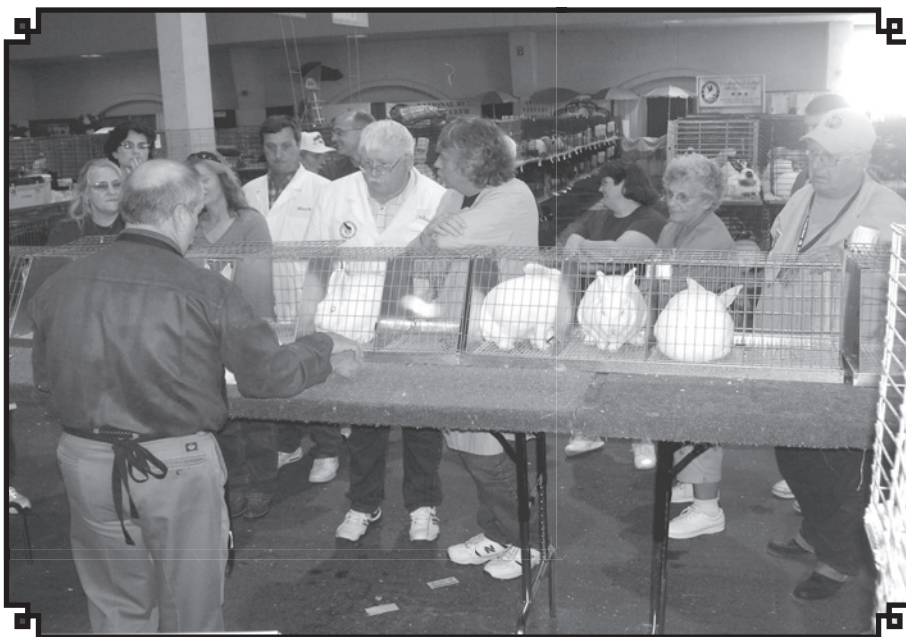

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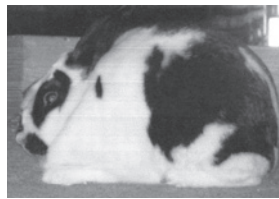
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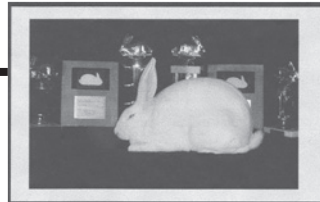

My hope is to provide some education as well as an update of our significant activities of the New Zealand Federation.

If you are not aware, we can now advertise on our website. Take some time and view the ads already posted and consider placing an ad of your own to promote your rabbitry and the New Zealand breed. This is a great opportunity as well as another funding source for our club.

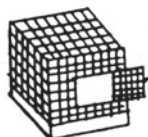
Lastly, as you begin the fall show season please be aware of potential disease transmission as you attend the shows. There have been numerous reports from breeders across the country experiencing significant death loss in their rabbitry following their return from a show. There are a growing number of breeders who are experiencing severe digestive upsets and death loss in their rabbitry after attending an extended cage type show like a convention or national breed show. Exposure to disease increases anytime you bring large numbers of animals together in one location. As a group of New Zealand breeders when we attend a convention or our national show we can help minimize the transmission of disease by removing rabbits from the show room that may be experiencing stress related ailments such as sneezing and mucous discharge. Leaving those individual rabbits in the show room only increases the chance of spreading the ailment to other rabbits. Maintaining a high level of sanitation at a show will also help to minimize

the transmission of disease. Last but not least, isolating your show herd from your main rabbitry following a big show can reduce the incidence and/or impact of a contagious disease or virus.

The article I submitted for this edition of the Times I wrote several months ago but I felt it would be good to revisit this topic as the show season quickly approaches.

Good luck to everyone attending the convention in Minnesota.

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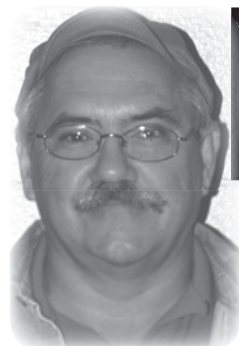
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Secretary-Treasurer Report by *John Neff*

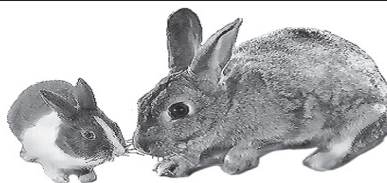

An interview with Mr. Guy Leger of Lake Charles, Louisiana

Guy is one of our New Zealand white top breeders.

Guy retired from rabbits back in 2006, but was known nationally for his very well conditioned New Zealands. Guy received his judging license in 1958. He judged at many convention and specialty shows over his 30 years as an active judge, retiring in 1998. He served this Federation as a director and both he and his wife Ethel were inducted into the New Zealand Rabbit Breeders Hall of Fame in the year 2000. Guy has won numerous awards over the years. He was awarded the ARBA Distinguished Service award in 1998 and in 1990 he received the Louisiana Rabbit Hall of Fame award, the first ever awarded in Louisiana.

Guy started raising Flemish Giants and Dutch back in 1947. Around 1953 Guy met Fibber McGehee and admired his New Zealand whites. He had some New Zealands shipped to him in Louisiana from a well known breeder in Nebraska. By 1956 Guy was out of Flemish and raising New Zealands as his primary breed. A good New Zealand cost about \$50.00 back then with a bred doe going for \$100. Guy added to his herd over the years with rabbits from Bagby and Zahn from Indiana and traded many New Zealands with his friend Fibber McGehee. Guy and his partner Don Hawkins won many big shows over the years in several states. Their biggest win was BOB and BOS in 1979 at the ARBA convention in Arizona.

The New Federation honored Guy by dedicating our last guidebook to him. Take time to read that dedication and learn all about this top rabbit breeder .

Guy is sharing his winning tips on getting that rabbit ready for a show and here they are;

1. Buy the best stock you can afford.
2. Be patient and observe your rabbits, look at all your litters carefully and learn to cull.
3. Look for a coat that is a little shorter in guard hair. A dense , thick coat is not going to condition well.
4. Feed a good fresh, balanced feed. Guy added a grain mixture of oats and barley to finish out his show rabbits, buying the best grade of grain you can find.

5. Keep those rabbits eating however you can. A rabbit that doesn't eat well will not condition well.

6. Show your rabbits in good competition. It is the only way to learn and improve your herd once you have accomplished the basics.

7. Finally , be a gracious winner or loser. You will win some shows you probably shouldn't have and you will definitely lose some you should have won. Share your knowledge to improve the breed.

Finally the most important bit of advice to all rabbit breeders is to enjoy the people you meet in your travels . Guy and Ethel miss the comradely that develops in our rabbit family. Raising those good winning rabbits is great , but it is the people you meet along the way that remain the best memory.

Guy and Ethel are doing pretty well as they contend with the restrictions that age brings to us all. They would love to hear from their old friends , so give them a call or write them a note.

Guy has shown under a lot of judges over the years and I asked him to name his favorites. He liked showing under quite a few but his 2 favorite were Fibber McGehee and Glen Carr.

Thank you Guy , who I am privileged to call a dear friend, for taking the time to do this interview. I feel that all the information gathered from our past New Zealand breeders can only benefit those of us coming behind them. I hope in the future new breeders will have been able to use some of the information gathered here to help in their rabbit program. When Paul and I started raising rabbits we read a lot and listened to many ,and then through trial and error found what worked for us.

Good luck to all in finding that perfect rabbit.



CONVENTION BUGS....



Anytime we exhibit our rabbits at a show we take the risk of exposing them to all kinds of diseases or as I refer to them as “BUGS”. It appears that many if not all of us bring some kind of bug home from a convention or national show where an extended stay is experienced. While our rabbits seemed to do well, it seems a silent BUG can spread during this time. I am going to share what myself and many other breeders have experienced after coming home from an extended coop show like a convention and/or national show. Let me back up just a bit. I always maintain a high level of herd health throughout the year with scheduled treatments for internal and external parasites (including worms, mites and coccidia) as well as maintaining a well ventilated and clean facility. Just prior to the convention all convention bound rabbits receive an electrolyte treatment prior/during and after the convention to help alleviate stress and deal with the city water at most convention sites. Having set the stage, let me progress getting back to the convention BUGS!

My rabbits ate and drank well all week at the convention except for one rabbit that did not eat the night prior to leaving for home. While this is not uncommon for one or a few rabbits to go off feed, it always throws up a red flag that something is about to rear its ugly head. All rabbits made the trip back home well with no signs of any problems except the one rabbit that had not eaten, it had dark pasty stool in the bottom of the carrier along with a pungent odor to the stool. This is not the first time I have experienced this kind of episode coming home from a major coop show like the convention, well the short of it is over a one week period following the convention the BUG HIT!!!!!!! This intestinal ailment began showing itself with rabbits going off feed, the appearance of a soft pasty black stool with a unique pungent odor that you could smell from outside the rabbitry. This episode affected rabbits which were exhibited at the convention as well as rabbits that never left home. The odd thing was that this BUG was randomly jumping through the rabbitry. It affected all age groups except young bunnies still with their mothers. I sensed this was not a bacterium but rather a virus was affecting my herd because of how it was moving and the kind of herd health program I follow dealing with

bacterial infections. So my focus was to identify what kind of viral infection was affecting these rabbits.

Symptoms I experienced were as follows: Rabbit stops eating, presence of soft pasty dark droppings sticking to cage floor with unique pungent odor. This episode lasts for 24-48 hours. I equate this to what we call a 24 hour virus in people. This is not the first time this has happened coming home from a convention but we have more experiences to rely on to begin to identify this BUG and see what we can do to minimize its' impact to our rabbitry. It also seemed the severity of this episode was tied to facility ventilation and length of stay in the facility. As I thought back over the last several years and the convention sites, it seemed that this infection was worse or present after we left a facility that was poorly ventilated vs. one that was well ventilated.

I spoke with a veterinarian Dr. Williamson, with Land-O-Lakes Purina located at their research facility in Gray Summit, Missouri. I shared my experiences with Dr. Williamson. She agreed that what I was describing and what several breeders were experiencing was probably some kind of virus rather than a bacterial infection. Dr. Williamson after a more in-depth literature research and discussion with colleagues about our conversation felt that this episode may well be that of a virus. There are several enteric viruses that can affect rabbits. Based on what we were experiencing there are two viruses that could be causing our problem. They are the Rota Virus and Corona Virus. The Rota Virus is most likely to be the problem as the symptoms described are found with animals having this virus. This virus affects the intestinal lining causing an inflammation and it is during this inflammation that we get the loss of appetite, pasty droppings and pungent odor. However within a short time (24-48 hours) the intestinal wall repairs itself and the rabbit goes back to eating and feeling good. My next question was, “What can we use to treat this ailment?” Dr. Williamson said there is not a treatment for a virus. Animals contract a viral infection and build immunity to the infection but that over time immune systems weaken and the infection can surface once again. Viruses spread easily through the air, physical contact etc. No different than spreading a cold or stomach virus in people. When you or I are under stress that is when an ailment can affect us this is no different for our bunnies! So anytime a large number, in this case rabbits are taken to a convention for exhibition we are exposing our animals to a



number of bacterial and viral BUGS and when you throw in poor ventilation, Waa La you have the perfect environment to spread disease.

This is what I found that works when affected by this particular viral infection.

1. Once rabbit goes off feed take rabbit pellets away except for a very small amount. By leaving a small amount you have some way to determine when the rabbit gets back its' appetite.

2. Feed a small amount of grass hay and/or comfrey.

3. Remember this is a viral not a bacterial infection so antibiotics do not work!

4. Do not feed rabbit pellets again for 48 hours or until rabbit eats the original pellets left in feeder.

5. Once the rabbit begins eating pellets, gradually bring them back on feed over a two to three day period.

6. This is not your general enteritis! This is a viral not bacterial infection.

7. Quarantine your show herd if at all possible from the rest of your herd when coming home from a major coop show.

8. Always disinfect water bowls and feeders with an iodine base disinfectant or good ole bleach (1 cap full per gallon water which is about 50-100 ppm concentration).

9. Automatic watering systems should be flushed and disinfected on a quarterly schedule and every two weeks during a disease event in the rabbitry.

10. Always consult a veterinarian before treating any rabbit!

This is not a case of blaming anyone or any site for the spread of disease. The convention host does their best job in providing facilities and housing for our rabbits. We have to take responsibility as owners/managers to become knowledgeable about these possible ailments and how we can eliminate or minimize their impact. We need to share our experiences to help each other through these episodes. I have learned a great deal about this experience and as a result I will be in a better position to deal with problems in the future. As long as we have shows we will have health issues arise with our animals' just part of the risk we take to enjoy this hobby.

I hope this article acts as a reminder of how important it is to be on our A game when it comes to managing and showing our rabbits.

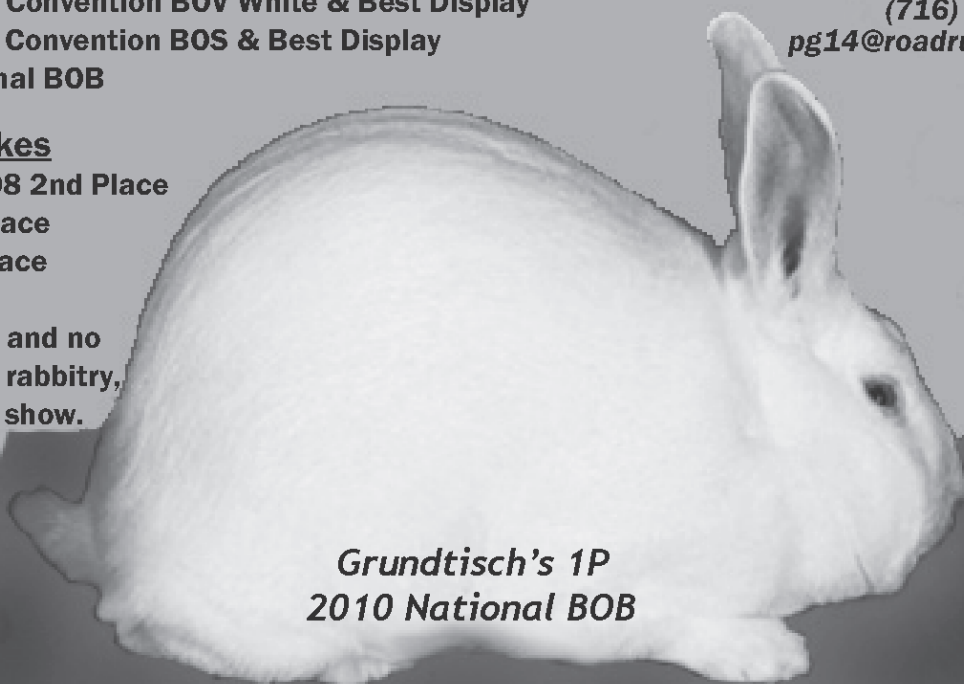
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Wry Neck

(A brief description based on research by Dr Wendy Feaga, MD)

Sign: Head turned to the side.

Cause: Protozoal infection, Encephalitozoon cuniculi, of the brain leading to encephalitis. By the time torticollis is seen, the organism is gone, and the disease is caused by the influx of lymphocytes and plasma cells.

Treatment: Injection of cortisone to reduce the inflammation. I had more success with injectable prednisolone than with dexamethasone. Tressaderm ear drops, 2 drops in each ear each day for 2 weeks have been useful.

Oxibendazole and fenbendazole have been shown in vitro to be effective, but may need to be given for 12 weeks.

Prevention: Spread by urine so make every cage isolated with dividers so rabbits cannot spray each other.

Comment: This disease tends to occur in 5 year cycles in rabbitries as rabbits develop an immunity which is passed to the first generation, but not to the next generation. After 5 years, there are enough susceptible animals to have another outbreak. Pitted kidneys are considered pathognomonic. Older rabbits will have polyurea and polydipsia. The brain form is wry neck and is very rare in comparison to the kidney form. There are antibody tests to confirm the diagnosis.



Frequently Asked Questions (Taken from the AFNZRB website)

Where do I get the best stock?

Ask around in your area, who sells quality animals? Are they available to answer questions for you? Cheaper is not always better. Be willing to pay a fair price. Look for experience.

What kind of barn and equipment?

Visit area rabbit breeders, if possible. A barn or cages that work great in the north may not work in the south. Buy the best you can afford and it will pay in your rabbit raising experience in the long run.

What is the best feed?

The freshest feed you can buy in your area that meets the basic needs of your rabbits. Feed the formula of rabbit feed that is made for what you are raising your rabbits for. If you are planning to show-feed a show formula. If you plan to raise for meat, feed a fast growing formula. Today most rabbit pellets are formulated for your rabbit's individual needs.

Do I add any supplements?

You will find as many answers to this as breeders you ask. The best advice we ever received is; listen to all advice and then decide what works best for you.

Automatic Watering system or Crocks?

This is an individual decision and may depend on the area of the country you live in. Automatic watering systems work better in the warmer parts of the country since they don't freeze in the winter. They also cut the chores in half and if you have a large rabbitry are well worth the extra expense. Crocks are less costly but time consuming. Some breeders like that they can see just what the rabbit is drinking in a day.

What are the best Nest Boxes?

Again an individual decision. Follow the manufacturer's recommendation for the size rabbit you raise. We have started using subterranean nest boxes and find them to be the most natural nest box for the does to raise a litter.

How do I decide which bunnies to keep?

Culling is one of the hardest things to learn. This is where experience and knowing your line of New Zealands comes into play. Keep the litter as long as possible and watch them grow. Find a New Zealand breeder that is willing to help you make these first decisions. Do not take your rabbits to a show and have a judge cull for you. Even a good New Zealand judge may not know this particular line of rabbits.

What age do we start to show our rabbits?

There are 3 classes for New Zealands. These are all listed in our guidebook under our standard. These classes go by age and weight. Be sure to look at both. Usually very young juniors cannot compete in a large class with those near 6 months of age and close to the 9 lb. maximum. All classes usually show the best nearer the top of their age and weight range.

Why does fur, worth just 15 points in our standard count so much on the show table?

The New Zealand rabbit is bred so closely to it's standard of perfection that a good quality class will come down to that 15 points on fur. We want to see the rabbit that wins the class represent the rabbit we all aspire to. We have a lot of great bodied New Zealands that meet the standard in every way, so sometimes it must come down to the condition of the rabbit that day.

Spring litters have arrived after much anticipation and with great expectations as the kits mature and develop into the perfect New Zealand. Well, that is all of our hopes each time a new litter arrives in the rabbitry.

Nest box management during the first 2-3 weeks after kindling will determine the success or failure of the developing rabbit. Several years ago I began to think about how to improve the air quality of the nest box for young kits. There they were, six to eight nice little bunnies in this tall sided wooden box filled with pine shavings and momma's fur. The kits were burrowed deeply in the nest box keeping each other warm and only coming out when it was time to eat. Then it hit me! Six or eight little bunnies using the same space to eat, sleep and GO TO THE BATHROOM!!!!!! Yuk. How clean could the air really be in this kind of an environment? Now mind you, I have always changed the nesting material and even built some duplex nest boxes with a false floor to separate the bunnies from their.....well you know. But as you can imagine this scenario did not really provide a quality air environment for the bunnies.

This is when I came up with the idea. How about constructing a smaller version of the nest box that addressed air quality as well as providing a comfortable area for the young bunnies. The result of this brainstorming was the construction of what is now known as the nursery box. The box can be made out of white pine or plywood (non-treated lumber), ½" x 1" floor wire and peg board. The finished nursery box is 14" wide x 8" deep (inside dimensions) with 4" high sides. Cut a half moon shape in the middle of the front panel that will allow the young bunnies to easily enter and exit. Cut a piece of floor wire and attach as the bottom of the box. Using the inside dimensions of the floor, cut a piece of peg board that can be used as an insert during cooler times of the year such as late fall, winter and early spring. Pine shavings are recommended for bedding during this time of year. During late spring, summer and early fall it is only necessary to use the wire floor.

I replace the nest box with a nursery box when the litter is two weeks of age for spring, summer and early fall born litters. For late fall, winter and early spring litters I use the nursery box at three weeks of age using the peg board floor insert with pine shavings as bedding. For my rabbitry this system works great! Individuals with outdoor hutches, especially during cold weather, using the nursery box may not be a viable option.

What I like most about nursery boxes is how they provide a quality air environment for litters which can prevent respiratory ailments such as snuffles. The other advantages observed are that the young bunnies will start eating pellets at an earlier age (3 weeks vs 4 weeks), stay cooler during times of warm temperatures because they can spread out in a more open environment.

So strap on your tool belt and construct a few nursery boxes and see for yourself the benefits of creating a clean air environment for those new arrivals.

Here are a few problems a rabbit can encounter, and some methods of First aid for same.

Fur Blockage

Sometimes long-haired breeds and molting rabbits of any breed can get fur or wool stuck in their stomach. The best way to prevent hairballs or impactions is to feed loose hay regularly. Feeding hay only (removing all other food) one day a week is very effective in preventing hairball formation. Rabbits cannot expel hairballs by vomiting so we need to use roughage to drive fur through the system.

First Aid:

If you suspect a fur blockage, remove all regular pellets and offer hay only, especially if you see their droppings strung together by strands of hair. If they do not eat the hay, buy a fresh pineapple, cut some up and put it in the blender, and see if they will drink it. If not, force feed 1/4 cup (for a medium-sized rabbit) of strained pineapple juice to the bunny twice a day using a feeding syringe until they willingly eat a considerable amount of hay a day. If they do not start eating within a day, visit your vet. You can purchase a feeding syringe from your dentist, it is used to irrigate teeth.

Fleas:

Use cat flea powder only. Never flea dip a rabbit. They are very susceptible to poison. A flea dipped rabbit can die within minutes.

Ear Mites:

Mitox or whatever your vet prescribes, works well. Keep it on hand. Completely disinfect the cage using diluted bleach (do not use Pinesol or other strong cleaners -- they are poisonous to rabbits) and rinse thoroughly. Do it again one week later, use cat flea powder for two weeks and replace all bedding when disinfecting or cleaning the cage. Ear mites or fur mites also may be responsible for excessive loss of fur.

Teary Eyes:

Terramycin eye ointment is available at feed stores. Wash the eye with warm water, and carefully trim wet fur around the eye. Follow directions on Terramycin ointment.

Enteritis

Signs: Soft, loose, watery, jelly or mucousy stools. May sit in water bowl, grinding teeth, does not eat.

Treatment: Put probiotics in water, use electrolyte replacement with pedialyte. Do not give pellets, give hay and quaker oats. Will need albon or other antibiotic. High mortality rate.

Red Urine:

Signs: Red or orange discolored urine that does not contain "clots"

Treatment: None. Too much protein in feed or hay.

Hutch burn

Signs: scabbed, inflamed vent area

Treatment: Keep cage clean, apply triple antibiotic cream to vent area until healed

GI Stasis

Symptoms: Rabbit not eating or eating less, not producing feces or producing feces that are smaller than normal, hunched in pain, loud grinding of teeth due to pain

Treatment: Gently massage abdomen to stimulate movement in the gastrointestinal tract. Simethicone (liquid is the cheapest form, and usually the easiest to administer) can reduce the amount of pain caused by gas bubbled. Give at 1 to 2 cc every hour for three hours, then reduce to 1 cc every 3 to 8 hours. Encourage the rabbit to eat good quality timothy hay. Hay can help restore the proper movements of the gut. Fresh leafy herbs, such as kale, mint, basil, dill, cilantro, or parsely can help to stimulate the rabbit's appetite. Soak the leaves in water for a few minutes to add extra moisture to them. Dehydration is a major cause of death in rabbits with G.I. stasis so it is important to keep the rabbit properly hydrated. 100 cc (approximated one ounce) per pound of body weight is needed each day to remain properly hydrated. Seek help from a rabbit knowledgeable veterinarian if the rabbit shows no signs of improvement within a few hours. G.I. stasis can quickly kill a rabbit.

Prevention: Provide quality timothy hay each day. Do not feed many treats that are high in carbohydrates (crackers, bread, etc.). Feed food that is at least 22% crude fiber. Make sure your rabbit drinks enough water each day to prevent dehydration.



How to Breed

General Information

1. The small breeds mature sexually earlier than the larger breeds. Small breeds may be bred at 4 months of age, medium breeds at 5-6 months, and large breeds at 9-12 months. Another method of determining breeding time is by weight. Breed does whenever they attain proper size (New Zealand and Californian at 7 lbs.). Proper feeding schedules thus insure earlier reproductive ages.

2. Start bucks one month later than does on a limited schedule.

3. Take doe to buck's cage; leave for one service. After about two minutes return her to her cage. If doe fights buck, remove immediately. She may be restrained for service or returned several days later.

4. If the service is completed, the buck will fall away from the doe. If this characteristic motion is not observed, remove the doe and place with another buck.

5. Doe ovulates about 10-13 hours after first service. Some producers take doe back for second service at this time. This doubles breeding time but may help conception percentage during off season (July-October).

6. Experienced producers should gently palpate does 17 days after breeding to see if doe is pregnant. Litters will be lost if does are handled roughly. Rebreed does that have not conceived.

7. In small herds, breed does twice to insure large numbers of viable sperm. In large herds when breeding daily, use bucks every day and breed each doe only once. When breeding weekly, bucks may service two or three does on the breeding day.

8. Keep one buck to every 10-20 does. Active high-producing bucks solve most breeding problems.

9. Add nest box at 28th day. Normal gestation period for rabbits is 31 days but varies from 30 to 33 days.

10. Replace any buck whose record reveals small litters or whose offspring show poor type or rate of gain.

11. Production life of good bucks is from two to four years. It is normal for males to molt for a one-month period during the year. During this time they may not breed.

12. Production life of good does is two to three years. Save at least one young replacement doe per month for each 24 working does (50% replacement per year). This replacement rate will generally cover both culling and mortality. Eliminate poorest animals continually.

13. Inbreeding is a much discussed point. The answer lies in degree of inbreeding and vitality of the stock. If fertility is low and young are few, misformed, unthrifty, or small, try a new unrelated buck.

How to Breed Commercial Breeders

1. In commercial meat production herds, the goal is to maximize the number of saleable fryers. Formerly, producers bred does every 42 days after kindling (31-day gestation). This 73-day breeding schedule produced five litters or 40 young rabbits per year. This is a good program for a beginner.

A more intense program now uses a 21-day breed-back schedule. The animal is bred every 52 days and produces 6 to 7 litters of young per year. To do this successfully, the young should be creep-fed milk supplement feeds to meet their nutritional needs and reduce their demands on the does. The young are removed from the doe by six weeks of age to allow a minimum 10-day dry period.

Does and litters should be observed frequently. Only the best stock will stand this intense schedule.

2. Replace does that produce fewer than seven healthy babies per litter.

3. Whenever superior does not excessively overweight fail to litter eight or more young, check the buck's record. He may be at fault. This is particularly true with very young bucks, old bucks, bucks going into a molt or that are overweight.

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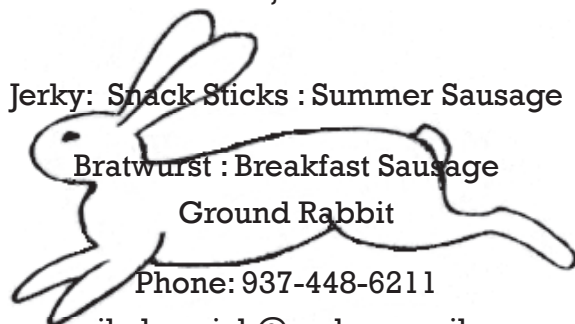
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
