# AMERICAN FEDEERATION OF NEW ZEALAND RABBIT BREEDERS GUIDELINES FOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND "ED CARPENTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP"

- 1. This fund will be governed solely by the American Federation of New Zealand Rabbit Breeders Association.
- The AFNZRB Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee shall consist of the Chairperson of the Youth Committee, three members and the Secretary/Treasurer of the Federation, as an ad hoc member.
- 3. All assets of this fund will be raised by voluntary contributions and fundraisers independent of federation finances.
- 4. All assets of this fund will be maintained in a separate account by the Secretary/Treasurer of the Federation.
- 5. The amount and number of scholarships is to be recommended by the Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee and approved by the Board of Directors. It will not be required to award a scholarship each year, depending on the availability of funds in the youth scholarship award account.
- 6. Scholarships will be paid by the Secretary/Treasurer upon written request from the Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee and prior approval of the Board of Directors.
- 7. A financial report of this fund will be made by the Secretary/Treasurer at the annual meeting and published in The New Zealand Times.
- 8. The decision on the recipient(s) will be made prior to the annual American Rabbit Breeders
  Association national convention and announced at the Federation banquet.
- The Scholarship Rules Sub-Committee will be responsible for application forms and criteria, while the Scholarship Awards Sub-Committee will be responsible for the selection of scholarship winners.
- 10. No scholarship application will be allowed from an applicant with a family member on either the Scholarship Awards or Scholarship Rules Sub-Committees at the time the application would be considered.
- 11. Applications sent out for scoring will not have the applicant's name or address on it to insure fairness.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR RECEIVING A SCHOLARSHIP

- A. The recipient must hold a current membership and have been an active member in good standing of the AFNZRB for at least two (2) consecutive years prior to submitting an application.
- B. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior or in their first year of college. If an applicant was turned down during their graduating senior year, they may apply again in their first year of college. Only one award per recipient.
- C. The recipient will be paid the scholarship monies when there is proof of tuition payment in an accredited two or four year college, university, vocational or trade school.
- D. Completed application forms must be submitted to the AFNZRB Secretary/Treasurer no later than <u>August 1<sup>st</sup> of the year that the scholarship is to be awarded.</u>
- E. The recipient must have raised and shown New Zealand Rabbits.
