Vice Presidents Message— Bob Swartz

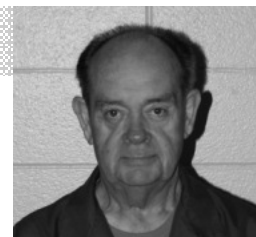
Greetings from Ohio once again! This is the time of year in the Northern United States that the rabbit world is on hold. I haven't seen a rabbit breeder since mid November when I judged my last show for 2008. We are blanketed with snow and an additional 2 to 4 inches of new snow is expected tonight and tomorrow.

I've only been able to raise one litter of 6 this winter. They are about 6 weeks old at this time. It was 17 degrees the day they were born. They survived one night of 15 degrees below zero. The old mother rabbit built a good nest. I did change the box three times in the first two weeks to keep them dry. The weather moderated a little when they were 3 weeks old, so I dumped the litter out. They are running around and doing

well. I don't know how they survive the below zero temperatures, but they do. I'm hoping none of them got their ears frosted. Not a good thing with Black New Zealand Rabbits. Time will tell!

The first Ohio show of 2009 is scheduled for February 1st at Lima, Ohio. It is only a week away at this time. They are predicting 30 degrees and no snow. I hope they are correct. I'm tired of being snowed in and thawing frozen water crocks day after day. It's time to get out in the real world and see friends and rabbit exhibitors. I'm really looking forward to spring this year. It's been an extremely tough winter. I'm anticipating the National New Zealand show at Bloomington, Illinois in April. Sweepstakes

We are working on updating the system to include the Meat Pens & Single Fryers when the new year starts and also the Broken & Blues once approved. Please see the short article about our Sweepstakes elsewhere in the Times.

Sweepstakes system:

I have covered this in the past in my Secretary Reports, but it needs to be mentioned again.

First & foremost, from the time you attend a show it could be 60-90 days before the show is reported and shows up on the website or in the Times. If you think there is an error in your points, the first thing you need to do is look at the Show Report that you got from the Show Secretary. If something isn't right, contact that Secretary. We can only go by what we receive. Also, show reports are to be filed with us within 30 days of the Show date. We are not to strict about this, and have accepted reports after this deadline. But, if updates have been sent to the website or Times, we can not accept late reports.

We do not monitor all sanctions to see if reports have been received. There is a lot of information that we need to prepare for these deadlines, and I hope you all realize this?

PLEASE check the list in each Times with Expiring Members information. We get phone calls requesting this info. We print this, you have a membership card with this info, and we still send out reminders in the mail when the dues are not paid in time. I am not sure what else we can or should do?

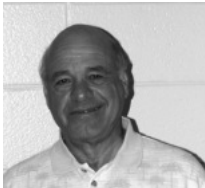
Directors Reports
