MESSAGE

ALREADY AND NOT YET

There is a theological concept of the "already and not yet" that describes the state of some good being experienced yet still desiring even more of that good to the point of complete satisfaction.

For example we can already experience the goodness of life through the resurrected Christ but one day we will experience a fully resurrected life in Christ.

Originally I thought the Beatitudes as being the opposite - first experiencing bad things in order to later experience good things: we have to be poor in order to become rich; sad to become joyful; meek in order to become powerful.... But now I see it as an 'already not yet' thing: since we experience something of the goodness of God now we realize how much we are lacking in this goodness and desire even more of the goodness of God to be received later.

There is a deep logic in this: we can't really desire more of a given thing unless we have an initial experience of the goodness of that thing. It's like when we are in an ice cream parlor and we try three different samples of ice cream but we ultimately choose the flavor that pleases us most!

So we are poor in spirit when we want more and more of God in our lives!

We are poor in mercy when we see how important mercy is to the world!!

We are humble and meek when we see all the good that can be done with the resources we have at our disposition!!!

May you all be blessed with the goodness of the Lord and may you continue to be blessed and ever blessed!

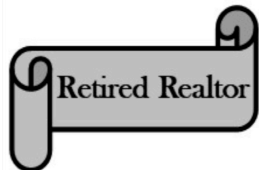

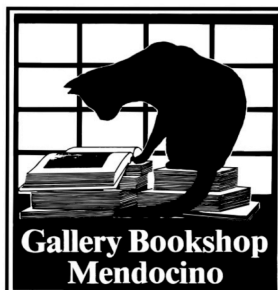
