In today's world what does it mean to take 'the lowest place'? We don't often have many banquets to attend.... And even in the special events we may attend, there aren't usually assigned seats as in the olden days when social status was so very important!

But what does it mean to take the lowest place? I can't help but think that every time we are inconvenienced; made to wait; or held back; we are taking the lowest place. When I'm in that shopping line becoming impatient because of the slowness they are taking to check out and I turn my heart to God and pray for the other people in that store, I'm taking the lowest place. When I have to wait on the phone for 20 zillion minutes until I get a hold of a real person to talk to and instead of becoming impatient - I pray for everyone who does this kind of work taking calls, I am taking the lowest place.


