West End Classic Tournament Rules and Regulations



Registration

- A representative from each team must check in at the tournament office prior to their first game. Check-in includes confirming team rosters and addressing any last-minute updates.
- Each player must sign the official game sheet before their first game to be eligible to play.
- Teams are encouraged to arrive at least 1 hour before their first game to ensure a smooth process.
- The tournament fee must be paid in full before the first game.

Coaching Staff Responsibilities

- Coaches must ensure players and parents understand and adhere to all tournament rules.
- Coaches are expected to promote good sportsmanship and a respectful atmosphere.
- It is the coach's responsibility to ensure player eligibility and timely game attendance.
- Any coach found playing an ineligible or suspended player may have their team disqualified from the tournament.

Rosters and Eligibility

- All players and non-playing staff must sign the official roster before participating.
- Game sheets must be signed by non-playing personnel before each game.
- Players can only play for one team per age group and cannot play in a younger division.
- Teams can carry up to 17 players, including goalies.
- A player must participate in at least two round-robin games to be eligible for semifinals or finals.

- Substitutes must be cleared with the on-site coordinator prior to playing.
- Fighting will not be tolerated. Any players involved in a fight will no longer be ineligible for the tournament. (Tournament director discretion)

Gameplay Rules

- All games follow Hockey Canada rules, unless otherwise noted.
- Period Length (for all divisions): 12-12-12 minutes
- Penalties:
 - Minor: 2 minutesMajor: 5 minutes
 - Misconduct: Immediate removal and subject to review
- Timeouts: One 30-second timeout per team in elimination games only
- Overtime Rules:
 - No OT in round-robin games (games may end in a tie)
 - Elimination games: 5-minute 3-on-3 sudden death; if still tied, a 3-player shootout followed by sudden death rounds
- Goal Differential Cap: Maximum +5 goal differential will be applied per game for standings/tiebreakers.
- If a team is trailing by 5 or more goals in the third period, the clock will switch to running time. If the goal difference is reduced to less than 5, stop time will resume.
- Early Start Notice: Games may begin up to 15 minutes before the scheduled time. Teams must be ready to go.

Divisions

The tournament features four divisions:

- U9
- U10
- U11
- U13

Each division consists of 4 teams.

Tournament Format

Round Robin (Days 1-2):

- Each team plays 3 round-robin games within their division.
- All teams advance to the semifinals based on round-robin standings.

Semifinals (Day 2) & Finals (Day 3):

- 1st vs 4th and 2nd vs 3rd within each division.
- Winners of the semifinals play in the division championship final.

Points System & Tie-Breakers

Win: 2 pointsTie: 1 pointLoss: 0 points

Tie-breakers (in order):

- 1. Head-to-head result
- 2. Goal differential (max +5 per game)
- 3. Goals for
- 4. Fewest goals allowed
- 5. Coin toss

Discipline & Conduct

- Zero Tolerance Policy:
 - Any verbal or physical abuse directed at referees, players, coaches, staff, or spectators will result in **immediate ejection** and possible suspension for the remainder of the tournament.
- This applies to players, coaches, and spectators.
- Tournament staff reserve the right to remove or ban any individual in violation of this policy.

General Rules

- Teams must supply their own warm-up pucks
- Only players and rostered bench staff are allowed on the bench
- Formal protests must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes of game end
