

ORDINANCE #95-4

An Ordinance prohibiting firms, corporations, persons or business enterprise to have, keep, or house on the exterior of the property or within an exterior building within the borough of Hop Bottom any mammal, reptile, or fowl, except dogs and cats and prescribing penalties for violation thereof.

The Borough of Hop Bottom hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, or business enterprise to keep, have, house, harbor, or keep custody on the exterior of the property or within an exterior building within the Borough of Hop Bottom, any animal, mammal, reptile, or fowl, except that dogs or cats will be allowed, provided that, no person owning any dog or cat to disturb the peace and quiet of the neighborhood by barking, making other loud or unusual noises, or by running through or across yards, cultivated gardens or fields. This Ordinance shall not preempt the duty of the owner of any dog or cat compelled of them or by any other existing ordinance or stature.

SECTION II

The provisions of this Ordinance shall not be applicable to persons, firms, or corporations existing on the Zoned Agricultural Areas in existence at the time of the passage of the Ordinance.

SECTION III

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, business enterprise to sell any offspring or by-product of any reptile, animal, mammal or fowl.

SECTION IV

Any person, firm, corporation, or business enterprise violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$100.00 plus costs of prosecution and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
