

ORDINANCE NO. 92-2

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, ENLARGEMENT, REPAIR, DEMOLITION, REMOVAL, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF ALL BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES: PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, COLLECTION OF FEES, MAKING OF INSPECTION; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; KNOWN AS THE BUILDING CODE; AND REPEALING EXISTING ORDINANCE NUMBER OF THE BOROUGH OF HOP BOTTOM, STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY the Borough Council of Hop Bottom as follows:

Section 1.00 - Adoption of BOCA National Codes including Building, Existing Structures, Fire and 1991 Supplement Codes.

That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Secretary of the Borough of Hop Bottom being marked and designated as "The BOCA National Building Code, The BOCA National Fire Prevention Code, The BOCA National Existing Structures Code and the BOCA National Codes 1990/1991 Supplement, Eleventh Edition, 1990", as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc. be and is hereby adopted as the Building Code of the Borough of Hop Bottom in the State of Pennsylvania; for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said BOCA National Codes, are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this Ordinance.

This ordinance shall become effective January 7, 1992

and shall remain in force until modified, amended, or rescinded, by the BOROUGH OF HOP BOTTOM, SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.
