

ORDINANCE 2007-13
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

SECTION 1. SPEED LIMIT

It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to be operated on the streets and highways of the Borough of Hop Bottom at a rate of speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS: SIGNS

a. The Council of Hop Bottom Borough shall have the power, by ordinance, to designate and establish stop intersections on any or all street and highways or to designate any and all streets and highways as one-way streets and highways. Such ordinances shall have the full force and effect as if incorporated in this chapter and shall be subject to the same fines and penalties as specified in this chapter.

b. The Streets Committee or any other committee appointed by the Hop Bottom Borough Council is hereby authorized to procure and place any signs and notices as may be necessary to enforce the provisions of this chapter

SECTION 3. OVERNIGHT PARKING OF CERTAIN VEHICLES PROHIBITED

No motor vehicle having an unloaded weight of more than four (4) tons {eight thousand (8000) pounds} shall park overnight upon any street or highway within the Borough of Hop Bottom.

SECTION 4. VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any person violating any part of this chapter shall pay a fine of fifteen (\$15), as well as the costs of prosecution, or in default of payment of the fine, shall be committed to the county prison for not more than ten (10 days).

This ordinance supercedes all previous ordinances related to traffic regulations.
