

## 11/12: US - Quito

Arrive at your departure airport in the US, ready for your flight to **Quito**\*. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel for check-in. Quito, Ecuador's capital, is renowned for its well-preserved colonial architecture, which earned it UNESCO World Heritage status in 1978. With its rich history, breathtaking views, and vibrant culture, the city seamlessly blends old-world charm with modern energy, making it one of the most captivating destinations in South America. Overnight stay in Quito.

\*If either your outbound or inbound flights depart in the early hours (before 4:00 a.m.), you must arrive at the airport the night before the scheduled departure day.



### 11/13: Quito - Tena - Amazon

Breakfast at the hotel. Throughout the day, a representative will contact you to review your full itinerary, day by day, and answer any questions you may have. In the morning, set out to **explore colonial Quito**, visiting a traditional market, the city's charming narrow streets, and its iconic plazas.

Afterward, journey from the **Ecuadorian highlands** to the highest point of the road in the **páramos of Papallacta** before descending into the eastern jungle. Upon arrival at the jungle lodge, enjoy a delicious included dinner.

Later, embark on an exciting **night walk around the lodge** to uncover the secrets of the Amazon after dark. This guided experience offers a rare glimpse into the region's fascinating nocturnal wildlife. Listen to the symphony of the jungle as you spot colorful frogs, spiders, owls, and even snakes—all under the guidance of an expert naturalist. This short yet captivating adventure is perfect for those looking to experience the rainforest's mystery and beauty at night without venturing too far. Overnight stay in Tena.

Distance covered today: 240 km by bus (approximately 6h).





## 11/14: Amazon

Full board at the lodge. This morning, set out on a guided wildlife walk through the secondary forest, a unique ecosystem that has regenerated after past disturbances, fostering a rich variety of plant and animal life. Wander along lush jungle trails and observe the region's incredible biodiversity up close. Keep an eye out for monkeys, colorful birds, frogs, and insects—and with a bit of luck, even sloths or wild cats. Walk through dense vegetation filled with towering trees, exotic plants, and medicinal flora used by indigenous communities. Guided by a naturalist, you'll gain insight into the intricate relationships between the Amazon's flora and fauna while immersing yourself in the sounds of the rainforest, from singing birds to the rustling leaves of hidden wildlife.

After lunch, enjoy free time to relax and unwind at the lodge's facilities. Overnight stay in Tena.

### 11/15: Amazon - Tena - Baños

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, we'll depart from Tena and head to the majestic city of **Baños**, renowned for its adventure sports and surrounded by stunning natural landscapes. During the journey, after approximately a 3.5-hour drive, we'll stop to admire the spectacular **Pailón del Diablo** waterfall, one of Ecuador's most breathtaking natural wonders. To fully appreciate its beauty, you'll take a 30-minute walk to reach a hanging bridge, offering a panoramic view of the impressive 80-metre waterfall of the Río Verde. The water cascades into a basin, creating swirling whirlpools and foam at the base, which is why the waterfall is named "Pailón," meaning a large pot or container, evoking the visual effect of the falling water.

You'll then have free time for lunch (not included). Afterward, the journey continues to Baños, where you'll pass by several other waterfalls, including the Manto de la Novia. Once in Baños, you'll have the opportunity to **sample the city's traditional sweets**: Melcochas and Sugar Cane Juice, both made from locally harvested sugarcane. We also recommend you indulge in our optional wellness experience with dinner\*. Overnight stay in Baños.

\*Wellness Experience with dinner: Unwind at the serene Luna Volcán Spa in Baños, Ecuador. Enjoy a traditional Baño de Cajón hot bath, relax in mineral-rich thermal pools, and savor a gourmet meal made from local ingredients, all while surrounded by breathtaking landscapes.


## 11/16: Baños - Quito

Breakfast at the hotel. Then depart from the natural beauty of Baños to return to Quito. If the weather permits, enjoy stunning views of the Avenue of the Volcanoes and the towering Cotopaxi Volcano.

Continue the journey with a visit to the Middle of the World, where you'll explore the **Inti Ñan Museum** and take part in fascinating experiments that demonstrate the unique effects of being right on the equator.

You'll also visit the **Middle of the World Monument**—the iconic landmark marking the equatorial line. Be sure to capture a memorable photo standing with one foot in the Northern Hemisphere and the other in the Southern Hemisphere! Overnight stay in Quito.

The total transfer time is approximately 5 hours, not including the visits made along the route.






## 11/17: Quito






# 11/18: Quito - San Cristobal, Galapagos Islands

Remember to download your e-ticket to confirm the times of your flights and to complete online check-in using the airline's website, or directly at the check-in desk at the airport.

Accommodation at the hotels is as indicated. In the event of any changes to accommodation, they will always be of the same, or a higher category. The category of hotels is not standardized across all countries in the world. For this reason, the criteria may differ depending on the destination country's own standards.

Galapagos transit control card (TCC) is mandatory and is checked at the airport in both Quito and Guayaquil before travel to the Galapagos Islands. Cost US\$20 per person (subject to change) and made by cash payment.

At the airport Galapagos passengers must present their transit control card (TCC) with their passport and pay the entrance fee to the Galapagos National Park. Cost: US\$100 per person until July 31, 2024, and from August 1, 2024 US\$200 for adults and US\$100 for children.

If you have reduced mobility, require the use of a wheelchair, or you would prefer this tour to be a private experience for you and your group, you must contact our Experts at +1 888-488-0592 before booking to ensure that your needs can be met.

While on the road, it is highly unlikely that the vehicle will be equipped with wifi or bathroom facilities, though rest stops will be made for long trips. We recommend purchasing a new SIM card at the airport or placing an e-SIM before travel to guarantee internet connection.

Room allocation: We will do our best to accommodate your family in the same room. If availability doesn't permit this, we guarantee your family will be accommodated as close together as possible. Children will always be accommodated in a room with at least 1 adult.

Transit Control Card (TCC) and entrance to the Galapagos National Park. Galapagos transit control card is mandatory and is checked at the airport in both Quito and Guayaquil before travel to the Galapagos Islands. Cost US\$20 per person (subject to change) and made by cash payment.

At the airport Galapagos passengers must present their transit control card (TCC) with their passport and pay the entrance fee to the Galapagos National Park. Cost: US\$200 for adults and US\$100 for children.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT VISAS, PASSPORTS AND VACCINATIONS

For domestic and international travel, please check entry requirements (e.g. USA and ESTA, Canada and eTA or other authorities, Schengen Area and ETIAS), passport validity (some countries require a passport validity of at least 6 months from the planned return date) and vaccination requirements (vaccination guidelines and COVID-19 testing requirements), set by the authorities of each of the destination and/or transit countries.
