List of conditions as subjected in accordance with the ordinances related to conduct of business.

1. This Permit is being issued subject to compliance with the following requirements, such as but not limited to, Locational Clearance, Fire Safety Inspection Certificate, Environmental Clearance, Sanitary Permit, and such other requirements set by law, ordinances, and that of other government agencies and/or instrumentalities relative to business operation. Non-compliance to these regulatory clearances and permits within 45 calendar days from date of issue of the business permit automatically revokes this permit.
2. The business is subject to inspection, whether random or periodic, during reasonable business hours pursuant to Section 81 of the Quezon City Revenue Code.
3. The business may be served notices, processes, correspondences, and other documents by this department, or any office of the city government, through their declared business address, electronic address, or contact details as indicated in the business application.
4. No business shall be conducted along government road right-of-way or sidewalk, nor shall the same obstruct vehicular and/or pedestrian traffic.
5. Business address or location may be affected by government projects.
6. The business shall ensure that each of its employees should have secured an Occupational Permit pursuant to Article 22, Sections 83-85 of the Quezon City Revenue Code, as amended.
7. The business operates as an "Office only" space. No storing or warehousing of merchandise or equipment shall be conducted at the business premises, whether temporary or permanent.
8. Prohibition on the commercial exploitation of women/men and girls/boys, including but not limited to the following acts: a) lewd shows; b) view rooms, display windows or "Aquariums", c) charging/payment of bar fines to bring out a personnel/employee of any night club, etc., as provided under Ordinance Nos. SP-123, S-93; SP-196, S-94; SP-218, S-94; SP-1516, S-2005; and, S-2501, S-2016.
9. Business operating as night clubs, karaoke bars, discos, and other similar establishments with private, function and/or VIP rooms shall neither have any lock nor other device that would prevent ingress thereto, and shall have clear and transparent windows pursuant to City Ordinance No. SP-1257, S-2003.
10. Gambling establishments should secure a fixed-term special permit from the Quezon City Council pursuant to Article III, Sections 2b and 3b of City Ordinance No SP-2773, S-2018, as amended. Likewise, it should not allow prohibited persons enumerated under Article IV, Section 3 of the same Ordinance to play therein.
11. Businesses operating within government-owned or operated public markets should have a valid market stall award and lease contract as certified by the Market Development and Administration Department (MDAD).
12. The business is subject to regulation on the manufacturing or selling of liquor under pertinent provisions of Ordinance No. NC-85, S-89 or the Quezon City Liquor Ordinance as amended and Ordinance No. SP-91, S-93 or the Quezon City Revenue Code as amended.
13. The business is subject to provisions of Ordinance No. SP-2791, S-2018, otherwise known as the Dangerous Drugs Code of Quezon City.
14. The business shall comply with the Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2003, Solo Parent Act of 2000, and Magna Carta for Disabled Persons Act, as amended.
