# **General Guidelines on Wellness Services**

(Community 'Kapon' Event)

## I. <u>VACCINATION</u>

- 1. Vaccine is given to an apparently healthy pet as early as 3 weeks old to both cats and dogs or depending on your veterinarian's assessment.
- 2. Give your pet a good bath before their vaccine schedule since they are required **to not take any shower** for a week after receiving a vaccine.
- 3. There can be some vaccine reaction that your pet may show after vaccination such as inappetence, weakness or vomiting within 24 hours of vaccination. Any reaction that persists more than the usual time must be reported to our team.
- 4. Stress must be avoided after vaccination such as travelling and playing to lessen the chance of vaccine reaction. It will also help to give your pet some treats and vitamins.
- 5. Most vaccines have follow-ups and schedules. Please be reminded that you are expected to register again for a new schedule for the follow-up vaccines needed, or you may visit another clinic near you.
- 6. Only registered veterinarians are authorized to vaccinate. Vaccine given by non-licensed veterinarians are void and invalid.
- 7. Vaccination rates in our community event are different with our private home service vaccination.
- 8. No fasting is needed for vaccination.
- 9. Not all diseases can be prevented by vaccines, other wellness services are needed to make sure they are protected, like tick and flea medications and deworming.
- 10. Sometimes, there can be small bump at the vaccination site. Applying cold compress will help it to subside faster.

- 11. Vaccination certificates can be given upon request and has separate corresponding fees.
- 12. <u>Proheart Vaccine (Heart Worm Vaccine)</u> dogs less than 1 year old may receive the vaccine without prior heart worm test, but those above 1 year old are required to have a negative test before receiving the vaccine. You can have your dog get tested to other veterinary clinics and send us the picture of the negative result at least a day before the schedule.

## II. <u>DEWORMING</u>

- 1. Dewormer is given to an apparently healthy pet as early as 2 weeks of age to both cats and dogs depending on your veterinarian's assessment.
- 2. There can be some reactions that your pet may show after deworming such as inappetence, weakness or releasing of worms through feces and vomitus within 24 hours of deworming. Any reaction that persists more than the usual time must be reported to our team.
- 3. Stress must be avoided after deworming such as travelling and playing to lessen the chance of reaction. It will also help to give your pet some treats and vitamins.
- 4. Deworming has sequence and schedules. Please be reminded that you are expected to register again for a new schedule to give your pet the follow-up dewormer needed until it is complete.
- 5. Deworming services rates in our community event is different with our private home service deworming.
- 6. No fasting is needed before deworming.

#### III. MICROCHIPPING

- 1. Microchip can be given at 8th weeks of age to pets.
- 2. No fasting is required and shower limitations for microchipping.
- 3. Microchipping certificates are available upon request. Soft copies are free, but printed copies have corresponding fees.
- 4. The registration of pet microchip number to a general microchip domain/website is the responsibility of the owner.
- 5. **It is not a GPS or any tracking device**, it is being used as an identification for pets and/is a requirement for some specific local and international travels.
- 6. It is only being given once.

#### IV. TICK and FLEA PRODUCTS

- 1. Tick and flea products can be given as early as 3 months or depending on the advice of the licensed veterinarian.
- 2. The effectivity of the product varies depending on its coverage, sensitivity and active chemical content.
- 3. The effect of tick and flea product lasts only for 1-3 months.
- 4. There can be some adverse effects or reactions due to pet's sensitivity to some chemical content of this product, thus caution is advised.
- 5. Rates of the product varies per brand and pet's weight.

**Important Notice**: Please be advised that you are expected to wait for a few minutes to few hours depending on the number of patients and situation on the day of the event.
