## GUIDELINES: VACCINATION, DEWORMING, AND MICROCHIPPING

The following guidelines are provided for informational purposes and to ensure proper understanding of the procedures, limitations, and responsibilities associated with veterinary preventive care services.

### I. VACCINATION

1. Vaccines are administered only to pets that are deemed **apparently healthy** based on general assessment, and may be given as early as six (6) weeks of age for both cats and dogs, subject to the professional judgment of the attending veterinarian.
2. The client is advised to bathe the pet **prior to vaccination**, as bathing may be restricted for up to seven (7) days post-vaccination, unless otherwise advised.
3. The client acknowledges that **vaccine reactions may occur**, including but not limited to decreased appetite, lethargy, vomiting, or localized swelling within twenty-four (24) hours. Any reaction that is severe, persistent, or beyond the expected duration must be reported immediately.
4. The client is responsible for **minimizing stress** post-vaccination, including avoiding travel, excessive activity, or exposure to stressful environments, as these may increase the likelihood of adverse reactions.
5. The client understands that most vaccines require **strict adherence to schedules and booster doses**. It is the sole responsibility of the client to ensure timely follow-up vaccinations, whether with the same provider or another veterinary facility.
6. Vaccinations are to be administered **only by duly licensed veterinarians**. Any vaccination performed by unlicensed individuals shall be considered invalid, and the veterinary team assumes no responsibility for such cases.
7. The client acknowledges that **rates may vary** between community events and private home service arrangements.
8. No fasting is required prior to vaccination.
9. The client understands that **vaccination does not guarantee complete protection** against all diseases. Additional preventive measures, including deworming, parasite control, and proper nutrition, are necessary for optimal health.
10. Mild localized reactions such as **swelling at the injection site** may occur. Basic supportive care (e.g., cold compress) may be applied as advised.
11. **Vaccination certificates** may be issued upon request and are subject to corresponding fees.
12. For **Heartworm Prevention (e.g., ProHeart)**:



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- Dogs below one (1) year of age may receive the injection without prior testing, subject to veterinary assessment.
- Dogs one (1) year and older are required to have a **negative heartworm test** prior to administration. The client may secure testing from another veterinary clinic and must provide valid proof prior to the scheduled service.

## II. DEWORMING

1. Deworming may be administered to pets as early as two (2) weeks of age, provided they are **apparently healthy**, and as determined by the attending veterinarian.
2. The client acknowledges that **post-deworming reactions may occur**, including but not limited to decreased appetite, lethargy, vomiting, or the passage of worms in feces or vomitus within twenty-four (24) hours. Persistent or severe reactions must be reported immediately.
3. The client is responsible for **reducing stress** after deworming, including limiting travel and strenuous activity.
4. Deworming requires **proper scheduling and completion of treatment cycles**. The client assumes full responsibility for ensuring follow-up treatments are completed.
5. Service fees may differ between **community-based events and private home service arrangements**.
6. No fasting is required prior to deworming.

## III. MICROCHIPPING

1. Microchipping may be performed on pets as early as eight (8) weeks of age, subject to veterinary assessment.
2. No fasting or bathing restrictions are required for microchipping.
3. **Microchipping certificates** may be issued upon request. Digital copies may be provided at no cost, while printed copies may be subject to fees.
4. The client acknowledges that **registration of the microchip number** in any database or registry is the sole responsibility of the pet owner.
5. The client understands that a microchip is **not a GPS or tracking device**, but a permanent identification system used for pet identification and may be required for certain travel or regulatory purposes.
6. Microchipping is generally performed **once per pet** and does not require repetition under normal circumstances.



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## IV. TICK AND FLEA PRODUCTS

1. Tick and flea products can be given as early as 3 months or depending on the advice of the licensed veterinarian.
2. The effectivity of the product varies depending on its coverage, sensitivity and active chemical content.
3. The effect of tick and flea product lasts only for 1-3 months.
4. There can be some adverse effects or reactions due to pet's sensitivity to some chemical content of this product, thus caution is advised.
5. Rates of the product varies per brand and pet's weight.

**Important Notice:** Please be advised that you are expected to wait for a few minutes to few hours depending on the number of patients and situation on the day of the event.

## V. GENERAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT

By proceeding with any of the above services, the client acknowledges that:

- All procedures carry inherent risks despite proper care and assessment;
- Outcomes may vary depending on the pet's condition, environment, and compliance with instructions;
- The client assumes full responsibility for post-procedure care, follow-up schedules, and monitoring; and
- The veterinary team shall not be held liable for adverse outcomes arising from non-compliance, delayed action, or factors beyond reasonable control, except in cases of proven gross negligence or willful misconduct.
