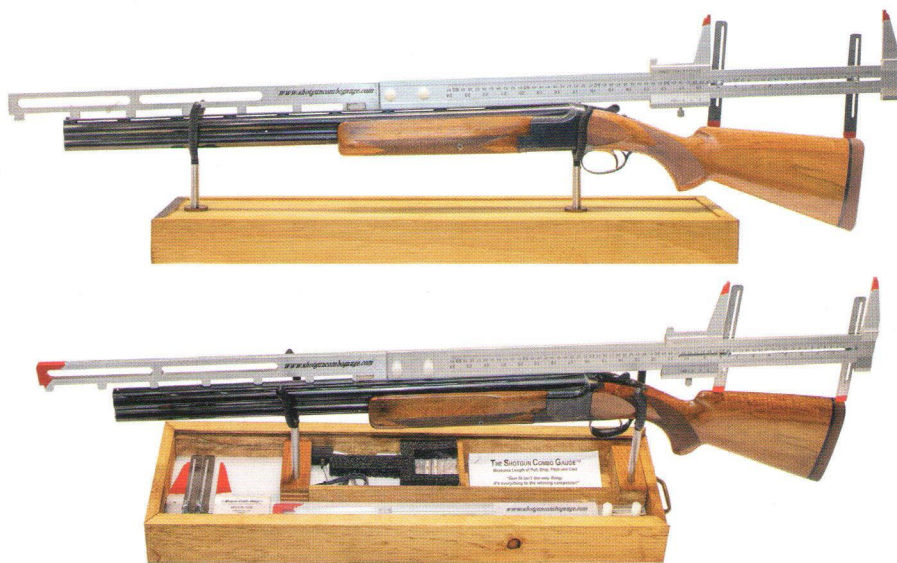


# The Complete Gun Fitter's Kit

**E**ven the finest shotgun in the world is of little value if it doesn't fit the shooter. Whether being used on a high-bird day in Devon or a tromp through the Wisconsin popples, a well-fitted gun is not a luxury; it's a prerequisite for consistent, confident shooting. Now any shooter can determine the measurements of a well-fit gun with the Complete Gun Fitter's Kit from Robert Louis Company.

The Complete Gun Fitter's Kit is a favorite among both professional gunsmiths and passionate hobbyists. At its core is the Shotgun Combo Gauge, an elegantly engineered vernier caliper designed to measure the crucial dimensions of length of pull, drop at comb and heel, pitch and cast. Whether you're modifying a stock or simply trying to understand why one shotgun feels more "right" than another, the Combo Gauge turns intuition into data.



Made of lightweight aircraft aluminum, the Combo Gauge reads in both inches and metric and is compatible with a 23" extension that magnetically locks to the barrel—freeing both hands for precision work. With the optional second Drop Meter, users can measure multiple dimensions simultaneously, speeding up the process and enhancing accuracy.

The Combo Gauge nests inside a handsome wooden Gun Fitter's Case, a compact carry case that doubles as a stable gun rest with two included yokes. It's a professional-looking toolkit that's equally at home on

the bench or at the range. For those seeking a complete fitting solution, the included Red LaserShooter (with four gauge inserts) allows users to see their point of impact via a muzzle-mounted red light.

Shooters who demand a great deal from their equipment—and from themselves—need to understand how a gun fits and what measurements best suit them. The Complete Gun Fitter's Kit doesn't just measure a gun; it reveals what's possible when a gun fits right. Price: \$747 to \$833.
