

### 3-LASER GUN NATION

*The sport of 3-Gun can be an expensive endeavor because you must supply ammo to three different kinds of firearms. Dry fire practice is always a solution but only your imagination can really tell you if you "hit" your target. The answer to that is using a laser.*

*The new 3-Gun Champion package includes laser inserts for pistols, shotguns and rifles (.22, .40, .44, .45, 9mm/.357, .308/.32 calibers, 12-gauge and a .223 extension). It works quite simple: fit the laser insert into your muzzle and attach the finger switch wire and bring it down to the trigger and you are ready to fire.
