

The same maker as the previously reviewed Shotgun Combo Gauge (*The Upland Almanac*, Autumn 2005) has come out with yet another value-added tool for the gunsmith or serious hobbyist.

The BoreMaster Mark III multi-bore gauge will measure bores from 4 gauge all the way to .410 and either fixed or screw-in chokes. It will measure chamber width, depth and forcing cone dimensions, as well. The BoreMaster Mark III may be used on rifle chambers of .405 caliber and up. A new feature allows the calculation of barrel wall thickness 6" from either muzzle or breech.

Spring-loaded probes and a digital readout scale allow for quick and accurate measurements, which can be obtained in either metric or English units in thousandths. The "zero-out" feature is achieved at the push of a button. Included in the BoreMaster Mark III kit are a calibration ring to keep the unit in spec – set at 0.725", an adjustable calibration screw to keep the system in spec forever, a calibration strip measuring 0.025" (actually a feeler gauge) that will verify the barrel wall thickness accuracy of the BoreMaster, and a plastic case.
