

Scenario Twelve - Evening Attack on Essling (Day One)

Starting Positions and Order of Appearance

May 21, 1809

Start 20:00 - End 23:00

Summary

Finally the Austrian 5th Column is in position to attack from Gros Enzersdorf

Boudet's division has been fighting all afternoon

and now must turn and face a new attacker

Dusk is falling and this will reduce the effectiveness of your units.

Some of the battle will be fought at night.

Abenddämmerung zum Nacht

(see the dusk rules starting with the 21:20 pm turn)

French that PGD, move West, leave the boundary and wait until they recover their morale.

Once recovered, the unit must wait one turn before re-entering the boundary area.

French re-enter from the West

Cavalry may not charge the turn they enter the map boundary

Austrians PGD to the East

If the Austrians take all hexes of Essling, the scenario is over.

Victory Conditions

French Decisive -hold two hexes of Aspern

French Decisive -hold four hexes of Aspern

French Decisive -hold all hexes of Aspern

Austrian Marginal - hold any hex of Essling

Austrian Substantial - hold three hexes of Essling

Austrian Decisive -hold all of Essling

The French or Austrians hold a hex if they were the last unit to occupy it by the end of the scenario
