

Scenario Thirteen - Lannes Retreat - (Day Two)

Starting Positions and Order of Appearance

May 22, 1809

Start 12:00 - End 15:00

Summary

The attack did not go well for the French. No reinforcements arrived.

The French Cavalrie has been driver back.

Both sides have suffered heavy casualties.

Napoleon has called for the retreat. Lannes must pull back to South of the road but slowly.

The French cannot allow Hollenzollern to gain the road hexes by the end of the 15:00 turn.

Use Morale Levels for the Austrians

Key

Initial Starting Locations

Historique Entry Times

French that PGD, move South, leave the boundary and wait until they recover their morale.

Once recovered, the unit must wait one turn before re-entering the boundary area.

French re-enter from the West

Cavalry may not charge the turn they enter the map boundary

Austrians PGD to the North

Victory Conditions

French Win - prevent Austrian Victory

Austrian Victory - place 30 increments South of the Road
