

**Second Largest Napoleonic Battle Goes On Sale 8-25-18 By ME**

***Marshal Enterprises (ME) Makes 2018 Publication La Bataille de Deutsch-Wagram 1809-- Set To Ship October 4, 2018***



Marshal Enterprises (ME) has announced that its 2018 Fall release, *La Bataille de Deutsch-Wagram 1809* will be on sale on the ME website [labataille.me](http://labataille.me) starting August 25, 2018 for shipping on October 4.

*La Bataille de Deutsch-Wagram 1809* can only be purchased directly from ME via its website. The price will be \$185.00 plus shipping. This will be another large publication by ME with 6 large maps and one smaller map as part of the package. In addition, there will be over 1500 counters representing the multi-national armies of the French Empire and the Austrians. Only 400 numbered copies will be sold.

The game will recreate the intense and grinding battle which occurred on July 5, 1809 and July 6, 1809 just outside Vienna between the 165,000 strong army of the French Empire led by the Emperor Napoleon; and the 145,000 strong Austrian army, under the Archduke Charles. The game is not a reprint of ME's original title published in the early 1980's, but is an all new game with all new research for the orders of battle and the maps.

The game can be linked to ME's *La Bataille d'Aspern Essling 1809*, or played without AE. There is a second game as part of the Wagram package called *Drive to the Bridges* includes the action near the Danube River occurring at the same time as Wagram. This game is an area movement contest.

There are several new features to *La Bataille de Deutsch-Wagram 1809* including a new terrain type called a feldlager—a sort of fortified semi-permanent encampment; special rules for Marshal Massena travelling via carriage during the battle; and the possibility of the Archduke John arriving at the battlefield in time to interject his fresh troops to assist his tired brother's army and defeat the French.

*La Bataille de Deutsch-Wagram 1809* is the sixth game ME will have published for sale since 2013. The Wagram title and *Drive to the Bridges* will be the 21<sup>st</sup> titles ME have published since 2011

Marshal Enterprises is a creative consortium of game designers and cultural commentators who remain the surviving designers of the original La Bataille system and are dedicated to the study and celebration of the Age of Napoleon and the Age of Revolution.
