- Water in the lungs



Flagged, but consistent with deceased's regular exposure to cleaning agents/paint thinner at hardware shop job

Conclusions

Knowing where the clothes were found and the body being found washed up next to the Cam, we can assume that the deceased entered the water from the Silver Street bridge. The broken arm and the skull impact suggest that they dived head first off the bridge. A broken arm and slight concussion would be more than enough to disable all but the most competent swimmer.

Water found in the lungs is entirely consistent with the Cam and the above-proposed sequence of events. Drowning, caused either by Suicide or Accident, is the most likely cause of death. Time of death was some time between 2330 and 2355 on 10th November 2010.
