Post-Mortem of HOLMES, RICHARD ANTHONY

Items found on the body:

- Wallet, leather, burnt out of recognition, gold American Express card
- ID card for Richard Anthony Holmes
- Unidentified thick metal object, burnt out of recognition
- Smart leather shoes
- Clothes burnt off

CAUSE OF DEATH: Smoke inhalation

Notes:

- Slight damage to the right knee, caused a maximum of 6 hours before death
- Body was found in room with wreckage of desk obstructing outward-opening door
- Third degree burns to 85% of body

Body Identified by:

Samuel Pinker, employer, identified body on Jan 13th - described Holmes as a cleaner.

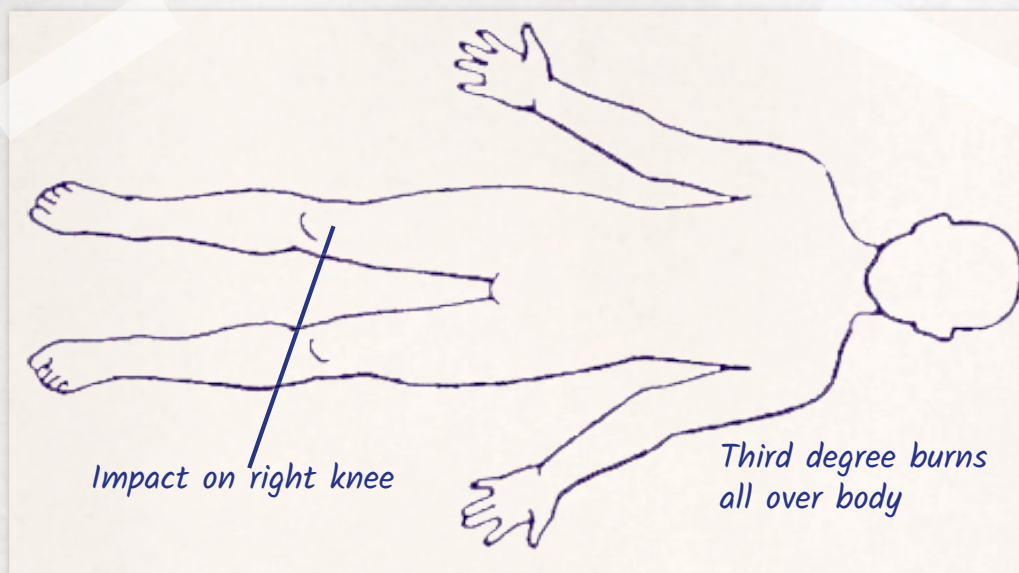


Fig. A (injury detail)
