Witness statement

“Well, I was only with Scott for a bit of last night. And not near the end. We were drinking together at The Anchor. He didn’t seem quite himself. He was quite pissed by the time I left, I think he had at least eight or nine pints - he was really putting it away. There were at least two moments where I took a break and he just got one for himself. I didn’t mind because he’d opened a tab and kept insisting it was all on him.

I wish I had stayed longer but I was invited back to my friend Mel’s house with some other friends and I wanted to get out of there. Mel had been working late and didn’t want to go to the pub.

My friend Reggie was with us too. Scott and she had been close in the past - not like that, he only had eyes for Sally - but they’d both decided to apply to be editor of *Varsity* and, well, if you know any students who care about that sort of thing you’ll know that people get very competitive. Look at what happened with Ben - he was drinking with me, Reggie and Scott for a bit but he’s trying to be editor too. So Ben and Scott had a bust-up and Ben left.”
