Ebola--Be Careful if you contact any one from West Africa and such other infected areas:

Ebola is caused by a virus
No vaccine is available to treat it.
Causes severe illness with bleeding.
Highly contagious
Up to 90 % of the infected die.
Sick people can spread the disease to others.
Family members and health care workers are the high risk victims
Even contact with dead bodies can cause infection.
do not touch dead bodies or wash or kiss dead bodies.
Do not wash hands in the same bucket if others have touched it.

Symptoms of Ebola:

Early symptoms include fever, nausea. head ache, Tiredness,

Late Symptoms vomiting, diarrhea, Coughing, bleeding etc.

Prevention if possible:

- 1) Wash hands using soap regularly.
- 2) Do not touch an infected person including blood, vomit. feces or urine.

3)Do not touch or eat bush meat and do not eat bats.

4) Call for medical help and tell them about the illness.5) May be sent to a spl hospital assigned for this our break only.

6)Keep away from others so that they do not get sick.

7)Be very careful about vomit and diarrhea.
