## Here are some things you will need to do BEFORE auditions:

- 1. **Sign up** to audition on **September 24 or 26** (Sign-ups are now a Google Form go to <u>OHSmusical.com</u>)
- 2. Fill out an **audition form** (This is also an online form go to OHSmusical.com)
- 3. Complete a **Conflict Calendar** & **Commitment Contract** (These are NOT online. You must complete hard copies and <u>bring to auditions</u>. Copies are outside Ms. Price's room room 103/black box.)
- 4. **Come PREPARED to your scheduled audition** (Days/times are listed on the Audition Sign-up. Auditions will be BY CHARACTER, so the character(s) for/with whom you want to audition will dictate when you need to be at auditions.)
- 5. Keep your schedule free for CALLBACKS on:
  - Friday, September 27 if you're called back for Supporting Role/Ensemble (3:15-5:30ish)
  - **▼ Tuesday, October 1** if you're called back for a **Lead Role (3:15-6:00)**

Make sure you work on the vocals (and potential callback scenes) provided to you in this packet in order to ensure confidence & success at your audition. We wish you all the best and look forward to seeing you soon!

# **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

Rehearsals are typically 3:15-5:30 or 6:00 (M-F); Some Saturdays required.

If cast, you will only need to attend rehearsals for YOUR character (acc. to rehearsal calendar)

**Choreography Rehearsals** begin the week of October 7 or October 14 (1 day/week)

**Blocking Rehearsals** begin November 18 (every day; you'll only need to attend those for your character)

**February Rehearsals** are mandatory for all cast. See Ms. Price if you're concerned about conflicts.

# SHOW SYNOPSIS

In the musical, Bert, a jack-of-all-trades, invites us into the world of London, England in 1910 – and, specifically, into the home of the Banks family. Jane and Michael, the young Banks children, have sent yet another nanny packing, dismissing these children as hopelessly and irrevocably spoiled and misbehaved. With a father who works constantly and mother who is always distracted, Jane and Michael have suffered without strong care-taking forces in their lives. Then the magical Mary Poppins flies in on the wind, bringing with her a combination of whimsy, magic, and disciplined common sense to the children's lives. Together, they go on memorable and magical adventures – and also learn the importance of a tidy nursery and of taking the medicine they need (with a spoonful of sugar, of course.) Mary Poppins' transformational influence does not stop with the children – eventually, she teaches the grown-ups, as well, to open up and realize that "anything can happen if you let it."

# **AUDITION / CALLBACK DETAILS**

# FIRST ROUND OF AUDITIONS in Choir Room:

Tuesday, September 24 (Lead Auditions)
Thursday, September 26 (Supporting / Ensemble Auditions)

- Prepare vocal piece of your choice (from list provided pg 4-5)...even if you don't want a singing role
- Sign up for an audition time that corresponds with the vocal piece you chose to audition with (see page 1).
- Be prompt to your audition, and bring your Conflict Calendar and signed Commitment Contract with you (see page 1). Note: You MUST have <u>all</u> conflicts listed on your Conflict Calendar. Prepare in advance for this by speaking with your parents and checking your calendar carefully!
- At the first round of auditions, you will sing your prepared piece and also be taught some movement by our choreographer, so wear clothes you can move in. (Remember, you do NOT need to be a singer/dancer...we just need to see you try, so do your best.)

# SECOND ROUND OF AUDITIONS (CALLBACKS) in Choir Room:

Tuesday, October 1 (Lead Callbacks)

Friday, September 27 (Supporting / Ensemble Callbacks)

- Callbacks are by invitation only. The callback list will be posted by Thursday, September 26 (after Ensemble auditions, so it may be posted later in the evening so the directing team has time to make choices).
- Prepare to attend callbacks if your name is on the list. We can not accommodate individuals' schedules, so plan <a href="now">now</a> to be there...just in case.
- Prepare callback pieces (vocals and potential scenes) for the character you're called back for. You may also be asked to move, so wear appropriate clothes.

# CHARACTER ROLES

(listed alphabetically)



### **ADMIRAL BOOM**

A retired Royal Navy man and neighbor of the Banks family. A physically large man with a loud and booming voice, he speaks in Navy jargon and has a soft spot for his neighbor, Miss Lark. Can be any vocal range as needed. Male, played 50-60 years old.

**BANK CHAIRMAN** The head of the bank where Mr. Banks is employed, is an Edwardian stuffed-shirt. He can speak/sing his lyrics if necessary. Male, played 50-60 years old. (Range: C3-D4)

### **BERT**

The narrator of the story, is a good friend to Mary Poppins. An everyman, Bert has many occupations, including hurdy-gurdy player, sidewalk artist, and chimney sweep. Bert watches over the children as well as the goings on in Cherry Tree Lane. He has charm, speaks with a Cockney accent, and is a song-and-dance-man.

Male, played 30-39 yrs old (Range: B2 - F#4)

### **BIRD WOMAN**

Covered in a patchwork of old shawls, and her pockets are stuffed with bags of crumbs for the birds. She tries to sell her crumbs for the birds. She tries to sell her crumbs to passerby, who ignore her as if she doesn't exist. Sings "Feed the Birds." There can be a gruff, folksy quality to her voice that reflects the hardness of her life.

Female, played 50-60 yrs old (Range: Gb3 - C5)

### **FNSFMRIF**

Annie, Fannie, Valentine, Teddy Bear, Mr. Punch, Doll, Chimney Sweeps, Toys, Park-goers

### **GEORGE BANKS**

The father to Jane and Michael Banks, is a banker to the very fiber of his being. Demanding "precision and order" in his household, he is a pipe- and-slippers man who doesn't have much to do with his children and believes that he had the perfect upbringing by his nanny, the cruel Miss Andrew. His emotional armor, however, conceals a sensitive soul. A baritone, George may speak-sing as necessary. Male, played 40-45 yrs old (Range: Bb2 - Eb4)

### **JANE BANKS**

The high-spirited daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Banks, is bright and precocious but can be willful and inclined to snobbishness. Female, 11 yrs old (Range: A3 - F#5)

### JOHN NORTHBROOK

An honest businessman seeking a loan to build a factory for his community. He speaks with an accent from Northern England. Male, played 30-50 yrs old

### KATIE NANNA (spoken role)

Jane and Michael's nanny at the beginning of the show. Overwhelmed and upset, she has absolutely had her fill of the Banks children. Female, played 30-40 yrs old

### **MARY POPPINS**

Jane and Michael Banks's new nanny. She is extraordinary and strange, neat and tidy, delightfully vain yet very particular, and sometimes a little frightening but always exciting. She is practically perfect in every way and always means what she says. A mezzo soprano with strong top notes, she should be able to move well. She can have a more traditional soprano sound, but precision and diction is the key. Female, played 20-30 yrs old (Range: Gb3 - C6)

### MICHAEL BANKS

The cute and cheeky son of Mr. and Mrs. Banks. Excitable and naughty, he adores his father and tries to be like him. Both he and Jane misbehave in order to get the attention of their parents.

Male, 9 yrs old (Range: A3 - E5)

### MISS ANDREW

George's overbearing and scary nanny. With her bottle of nasty-tasting brimstone and treacle to keep naughty children in line, she is a bully who only knows one way of doing things - her way. A soprano with an alto belt, there can be some heaviness to her voice along with the range. Female, played 40-60 yrs old (Range: Gb3 - F5)

### MISS LARK

The haughty next-door neighbor of the Banks family who treats her dog, Willoughby, as if he were her child. Female, played 30-40 yrs old

### MISS SMYTHE

The Bank Chairman's humorless secretary. Female, played 40-50 yrs old

### MRS. BRILL

The housekeeper and cook for the Banks family. Overworked and harassed, she's always complaining that the house is understaffed. Her intimidating exterior is a cover for the warmth underneath. Mrs. Brill doesn't have a high opinion of nannies in general and Mary Poppins in particular. She does not have to be a strong singer.

Female, played 50-60 yrs old (Range: F#3 - D#5)

### MRS. CORRY

Owns a magical gingerbread shop. She is a mysterious woman of great age who speaks with a Caribbean accent (or any accent that would make her seem exotic). Female, played 40-50 yrs old

### **NELEUS**

The statue of a young boy posed with a dolphin in the park. Neleus was separated from his father, Poseidon, and misses him very much. A small and lonely being, he is very happy to befriend Jane and Michael. This role is an opportunity for a strong dancer.

### **PARK KEEPER**

Uniformed and officious, he makes sure no one breaks park regulations. His life is defined by rules, but he secretly hankers after his childhood. Male, played 40-60 yrs old

### **POLICEMAN**

A neighborhood fixture who is respected by and observant of the households on his beat. Male, played 30-50 yrs old

### **QUEEN VICTORIA**

A statue in the park. Female, played 40-60 yrs old

### **ROBERTSON AY**

The houseboy to the Banks family. Lazy, sleepy, and grumbling, he never gets things right and believes himself to be useless. He doesn't do a lot of singing, but his "Spoonful" solo can be a fun surprise.

Male, played 20-30 yrs old (Range: F3 - G#4)

### **VON HUSSLER**

A businessman seeking a loan from the bank for a shady business deal. He speaks with a German accent. Male, played 30-50 yrs old

### WINIFRED BANKS

George's wife and Jane and Michael's mother. A former actress, she is a loving and distracted homemaker who is busy trying to live up to her husband's desire to only associate with "the best people" as well as be a model wife and mother. She suffers from the conflicting feelings that she's not up to the job of "being Mrs. Banks," yet, she is, and more. She has a great warmth and simplicity to her tone. Female, played 30-40 yrs old (Range: A3 - D5)
