

Welcome to Auditions for LITTLE MERMAID!

(LEAD CHARACTER AUDITIONS)

When you arrive, please...

1. **HIGHLIGHT** your name on the sign-in list & write the **time** you arrived.
2. **Fill out a NAME TAG in Sharpie** (write NEATLY & large enough to see at a distance)
3. **Put your Audition NUMBER** (from the sign-in sheet) **on the upper right side of your NAME TAG and AUDITION FORM.**
4. **Download Band app (required)**- see Stage Manager or use QR code posted.
5. **Give your COMPLETED forms to the Stage Manager** (**Audition Form & Conflict Calendar/Commitment Contract** - You **MUST** have your Audition Form completed. If you need time to finish the others - or take them home to your parents - let the SM know.)
6. **STAY CLOSE** enough to the audition room to be heard when we call your group (have a seat in hall chairs provided or rehearse in the posted rehearsal space).

When it's your turn, the Stage Manager will call you by **character groups**. Proceed to the chairs in the audition room, and wait until you're called up for YOUR audition. Your audition will be 1-2 minutes so we have enough time to get through everyone.

There will be a live **pianist** (Mrs. Flynn) accompanying you when you sing.

Once inside the audition room, please...

- ★ Have a seat in the chairs provided. **Remain QUIET unless addressed, please...**No clapping or talking before/after/during auditions.
- ★ When it's your turn:
 - ★ **Proceed** to the on the X on the floor
 - ★ **Tell** the Pianist which piece you're singing
 - ★ **Introduce** yourself to the auditioning team by telling them your name and character for whom you are auditioning...and then begin! (*You will hear a short intro from the piano and once you start singing the pianist will follow YOU.*)

Remember, we WANT you to do well, so relax and enjoy sharing your talents with us! Also, remember that **even if you make a mistake, we (the auditioning team) are professionals and can see past mistakes** to your potential/talent. Don't assume you've blown your audition if you make a mistake. **Theatre is more about how you HANDLE a mistake, not if you make one.**

You are amazing just for being here.
Now show us what you have to offer, and earn that role! :)
