Triangle Boulevard Improvements

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Project Summary

To provide operational improvements for Triangle Boulevard, a two - lane divided collector roadway between Collier Boulevard (County Road 951) and US 41, US 41 at Triangle Boulevard and Price Street (a total distance of 0.52 miles):

- Sidewalk improvements on both sides along Triangle Boulevard and Price Street.
- Median modifications will increase turn lane capacity and traffic flow at US 41 and Triangle Boulevard, Price Street and US 41 and all along the Triangle Boulevard corridor.
- A roundabout at Celeste and Triangle Boulevard and a U-Turn movement at Price Street and Waterford Drive will be added to increase traffic flow and relieve congestion.

Project Site





Project Status: Timeline and Budget

- On March 6, 2019, the Surtax Committee validated expenditures in the amount of \$6,000,000 as Surtax Funding.
- The design and permitting is completed. Construction bids are due back in November 2020. Construction to start late 2020 or after season 2021.
- \$14,338 has been spent to date and \$2,845 is committed to be spent for Right of Way.
