

BARN RULES

- Horses are not to be ridden by any person other than the owner unless the rider has read, filled out and signed:
 - Release and Waiver of Liability
 - Atlantic Equestrian Barn Rules
- Visiting horses and riders must be approved by Atlantic Equestrian beforehand and must read, fill out and sign:
 - Release and Waiver of Liability
 - Atlantic Equestrian Barn Rules
- Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking areas (please see Site Map attached)
- All gates and doors are to be kept closed at all times (unless notices are posted directing otherwise)
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times and are not permitted in the indoor or outdoor arenas
- Please pick up and dispose of all poop left by your dog. Poop bags and water are available at the Dog Care station by the barn
- Please inform Atlantic Equestrian well in advance of when vets, farriers or other service providers are scheduled by the owner to visit
- Please do not feed any horses other than your own
- Do not run in any of the barns or near the horses
- Please ensure younger children are supervised at all times
- Please exercise caution when large machinery is operating on the farm, ensure eye contact with the operator so you know they have seen you
- Do not use any machinery, equipment or tools at any time





- Please do not fix, repair, alter or otherwise change any fixture or fitting at the Barn. If you see an item that needs our attention, please let us know
- Please use the garbage and recycling bins in the barns for garbage and recycling. The green bin near the garage is for Atlantic Equestrian use only
- Please ensure all brooms, shovels and scoops are returned to the relevant storage area after use
- Before entering the riding arena, please knock loudly and shout 'door' before entering
- Please turn off power/lights when you are finished in the barns
- Please be kind and considerate to your fellow boarders/riders at all times
- Please only park in designated parking areas (see Site Map attached and follow signage on site)
- Atlantic Equestrian is not responsible for damage or loss of property, tack, vehicles, or horses so boarders/riders are encouraged to be covered by appropriate insurance
- Please wear appropriate clothing and footwear when at the barn. Open toed shoes are not permitted while handling horses and riding helmets are mandatory
- Boarders are required to clean up after their horses when in the boarders care. This means cross ties, wash rack, alleyway, and arena and anywhere outside of pens or stalls are to be cleaned of dirt or manure after use. Boarders are also responsible for cleaning up laundry facilities after use
- Please use a halter and lead rope on your horse when walking around the barn, do not lead by a halter alone
- Never leave a tied horse unattended

Provisions for taking your horse off site

- Please contact us to advise when your horse is leaving and returning to the property ahead of time. Please do this in all instances
- Please make arrangements for feed while off site. Atlantic Equestrian will be happy to supply your horses regular feed but, we need to be aware ahead of time

Club Room

The clubroom is open to boarders but on some occasions may be closed for functions or classes





- Fridge and cupboard space is available for all boarders in the club room
- Please clean up after yourself, put away equipment, garbage and furniture, and do not leave any dirty dishes in the sink

Riding Arenas

- Follow the left shoulder to left shoulder passing rule
- No lunging in the arena when 2 or more horses are already being ridden or more than one horse is already being lunged.
- No lunging during lessons
- Only one horse at a time may be free lunged and only if there are no riders in the arena
- No riding in the barn or alleyways. Always dismount before leaving the riding arena or entering the barn
- Jumping is allowed only under the supervision of an experienced rider of legal age or qualified coach
- No jumping alone
- Please put away all jump standards and poles after use
- Please remove manure from riding arena into buckets provided when finished riding
- Please do not overfill the manure buckets either use another one (stored outside *(&*&&() or let us know and we will change it over
- Please turn off all lights when leaving and close all doors
- Please do not change any heating controls

Viewing Area

- Please put away any garbage and put furniture back in order
- Ensure that alleyways etc are not blocked
- Please keep noise and movement to a minimum so horses and riders are not distracted





• Spectators should not interrupt coaches during lessons
