

EVERGREEN SHRUBS

Important Information About Growing BROADLEAF EVERGREENS in Utah:

Because of Utah's unique climate, Jerry's Nursery & Garden Center recommends that most broad-leaf evergreens (**Boxwoods, Euonymus, Hollies, Laurels, Rhododendrons, etc.**) be planted in shade or afternoon shade. Please refer to our descriptions and signs, and ignore any grower tags, books, or other information that suggests planting these plants in full sun.

Our combination of extremely low humidity, high altitude, hot summers, and cold winters is very hard on these plants unless they are somewhat protected. By contrast, the vast majority of the U.S. population lives much closer to sea level with high humidity and thicker atmosphere, which blocks some of the sun's rays. Their summers aren't as hot, and their winters aren't as cold, thus they can grow these same plants successfully in full sun.

We cannot guarantee broadleaf evergreens that are planted in full sun or afternoon sun unless it is a variety that our Jerry's Nursery & Garden Center descriptions and tags say you can plant there. Your success is our goal, so *please refer only to our tags and descriptions for cultural information.*



Abies balsamea 'Nana' (Dwarf Balsam Fir) - Zone 3. 1-2 feet high x 2-3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full shade or afternoon shade. Moderate or moist soil. Soft, light green new growth hardens to dark green. Forms a dense, round mound.



Andromeda polifolia 'Nana' (Bog Andromeda, Bog Rosemary) - Zone 2. 10-12 inches high x 18 inches wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist acid soil. Blooms April-May with small pinkish-white flowers. Dark green leathery leaves.



Andromeda polifolia 'Blue Ice' (Blue Ice Bog Andromeda) - Zone 2. 1-2 feet high x 2-3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist acid soil. Spring blooming delicate pink flowers. Attractive powder blue leaves.



Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Massachusetts' (Massachusetts Kinnikinnick) - Zone 2. 6 inches high x 2-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry or moderate soil. Small pinkish white flowers in April or May. Bright red berries in late summer. Good ground cover. Do not fertilize. Drought tolerant.



Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Wood's Compact' (Wood's Compact Kinnikinnick) - Zone 2. 3 inches high x 18 inches wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry or moderate soil. Small pinkish white flowers in April or May. Bright red berries in late summer. Compact variety with dark green, rounded leaves. A good ground cover or rock garden plant. Do not fertilize. Drought tolerant.



Artemisia tridentata vaseyana (**Mountain Big Sagebrush**) - Zone 3. 3-6 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Full sun. Dry soil. Strongly aromatic silver foliage. Drought tolerant native.



Buxus microphylla 'Golden Triumph' (**Golden Triumph Boxwood**) - Zone 5. 3 feet high x 4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Glossy, dark green leaves with bright yellow edges. Takes pruning very well. Excellent for hedging. *We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side. NEW FOR 2018.



Buxus microphylla japonica 'Green Mountain' (**Green Mountain Boxwood**) - Zone 5. 5 feet high x 3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Shiny, small dark green leaves. Forms a perfect pyramidal oval. Excellent for hedging. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Buxus microphylla koreana 'Franklin's Gem' (**Franklin's Gem Korean Boxwood**) - Zone 4. 2 feet high x 3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. One of the hardiest boxwoods. Bright green leaves that turn olive green in winter. A broadly mounding shrub. Excellent for hedging. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side. NEW FOR 2019



Buxus microphylla koreana 'Winter Gem' (**Winter Gem Korean Boxwood**) - Zone 5. 3-4 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Very hardy Boxwood. Shiny deep green leaves that hold color well in winter. Excellent for hedging. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Buxus sempervirens* 'Elegantissima' (Variegated Common Boxwood**) - Zone 5. 5-8 feet high x 5-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Pretty boxwood with creamy white edges on the green leaves. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Buxus sempervirens 'Green Tower' (**Green Tower Boxwood**) - Zone 5. 9 feet high x 1-2 feet wide. Slow to moderate growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Beautiful narrow plant with dark green leaves. Great for small spaces and narrow sideyards. Excellent for hedging. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side. NEW FOR 2016



Buxus sempervirens 'Suffruticosa' (**True Dwarf Boxwood, Dwarf English Boxwood**) - Zone 5. 3-4 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Very slow growth rate. Partial shade or full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Very dense, compact plant with dark green leaves. Excellent for hedging. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'Strict Weeping' (**Strict Weeping Alaskan Cedar**) - Zone 5. 30-40 feet high x 5-12 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, about 12 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Very strict weeping branches hanging down usually right against the trunk making this a very narrow form. Nice dark green foliage. Unique, informal growth habit.



Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Filicoides Compacta' (**Dwarf Fernspray Hinoki Cypress**) - Zone 5. 10-15 feet high x 10-15 feet wide. Slow to moderate growth rate. Full shade or afternoon shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Beautiful bright green fernlike foliage.



Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Nana Gracilis' (**Dwarf Hinoki Cypress**) - Zone 4. 3-4 feet high x 2-3 feet wide. Very slow growth rate. Full shade or afternoon shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. A compact, dark green shrub with an interesting, irregular growth habit.



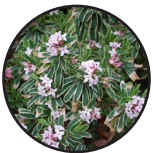
Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Filifera' (**Threadbranch Cypress**) - Zone 4. 8-15 feet high x 8-15 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Full sun or afternoon shade. Moist, well-drained soil. Protect from strong winds. A fine-textured large shrub or small tree with drooping, thread-like green foliage.



Chamaecyparis pisifera filifera 'Vintage Gold' (**Dwarf Golden Threadbranch Cypress**) - Zone 5. 2 & 1/2 - 3 feet high x 2 & 1/2 - 3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or afternoon shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Thread-like golden-yellow leaves on a compact rounded plant. Plant may burn in full sun.



Chrysothamnus nauseosus (**Rubber Rabbitbrush**) - Zone 3. 2-4 feet high x 2-4 feet wide. Full sun. Dry soil. Golden yellow flowers in fall. Drought tolerant native with aromatic, gray-green leaves.



Daphne x burkwoodii 'Carol Mackie' (**Carol Mackie Daphne**) - Zone 4. 2-4 feet high x 3-5 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade, protected area. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Extremely fragrant clusters of light pink flowers in the spring. Green foliage with narrow creamy-yellow leaf edges. Place shredded bark around the plant to keep the roots cool. All Daphnes are temperamental, short-lived shrubs that **MUST** have well drained soil and can die for no apparent reason. They are worthwhile for their intense fragrance and beauty, so enjoy them while they last and then plant another one!



Daphne cneorum 'Ruby Glow' (**Ruby Glow Daphne**) - Zone 4. 6-12 inches high x 2 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Dark pink fragrant flowers in April-May. Place shredded bark around the plant to keep the roots cool. All Daphnes are temperamental, short-lived shrubs that **MUST** have well drained soil and can die for no apparent reason. They are worthwhile for their intense fragrance and beauty, so enjoy them while they last and then plant another one!



Erica x darleyensis 'Mediterranean Pink' (**Mediterranean Pink Heath**) - Zone 4. 1 foot high x 2 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Rosy-pink flowers February - May.



Erica x darleyensis 'Mediterranean White' (**Mediterranean White Heath**) - Zone 4. 1 foot high x 2 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. White flowers February - May.



Euonymus fortunei 'Colorata' (**Wintercreeper Euonymus**) - Zone 4. 1 - 1 & 1/2 feet high x 3-6 feet wide groundcover. Fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Deep glossy green leaves. Reddish-purple fall and winter color. Use as a groundcover.



Euonymus fortunei 'Emerald Gaiety' (**Emerald Gaiety Euonymus**) - Zone 5. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Afternoon shade or full shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Dark green leaves with white edges. Pinkish winter color. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Euonymus fortunei 'Emerald n' Gold' (**Emerald n' Gold Euonymus**) - Zone 5. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Afternoon shade or full shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Dark green leaves with yellow edges. Pinkish winter color. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Euonymus fortunei 'Goldsplash' (**Goldsplash Euonymus**) - Zone 5. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Full shade or afternoon shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Big round leaves with a thick golden yellow edge. Very showy and consistent leaf coloration. Disease resistant. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side. A Proven Winners Color Choice Variety.



Euonymus fortunei 'Moonshadow' (**Moonshadow Euonymus**) - Zone 5. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Full shade or afternoon shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Bright yellow leaves with deep green edges. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Euonymus japonica 'Aureo-marginata' (**Golden Euonymus**) - Zone 6. 6-8 feet high x 6 feet wide. Medium to fast growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Glossy, dark green leaf with bright yellow edges. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Euonymus japonica 'Aureo-variegata' (**Goldspot Euonymus**) - Zone 6. 6-8 feet high x 6 feet wide. Medium to fast growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Bright yellow leaves with dark green edges. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Euonymus japonica 'Grandifolia' (**Evergreen Euonymus, Japanese Euonymus**) - Zone 5. 8 feet high x 6 feet wide. Medium to fast growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Large, shiny green leaves. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Euonymus japonica 'Silver King' (**Silver King Euonymus**) - Zone 6. 6-8 feet high x 6 feet wide. Medium to fast growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade, protected area. Any soil that is not extremely wet. Large pale green leaves with creamy white edges. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Hesperaloe parviflora 'Brake Lights' (**Red Yucca**) - Zone 5. 2-3 feet high x 2-3 feet wide. Slow growing. Full sun. Dry to moderate, well-drained soil. Good for hot areas with reflected heat. Narrow, evergreen gray-green leaves edged with white fibers. 3-4 foot tall spikes of vibrant brake-light red flowers from late spring to mid summer. Attracts hummingbirds. Native to Texas and Mexico. Drought tolerant, but also grows well with regular watering. NEW FOR 2016

Ilex x meserveae 'Blue Prince' (**Blue Prince Holly**) - Zone 4. 8-12 feet high x 6-8 feet wide.



Slow growth rate. Partial to full shade, protected area. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Lustrous, leathery dark green leaves. Male, pollinates female varieties. Has a dense, shrubby habit and is easy to prune into any shape. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Ilex x meserveae 'Blue Princess' (**Blue Princess Holly**) - Zone 4. 8-15 feet high x 8-10 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Partial to full shade, protected area. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Female with abundant, dark red fruits. Lustrous, dark bluish green leaves. Needs a male pollinator. A broad, shrubby plant that is easy to prune into any shape. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.

JUNIPERUS (JUNIPER) SPREADING TYPES:



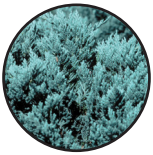
Juniperus chinensis 'San Jose' (**San Jose Juniper**) - Zone 4. 1-2 feet high x 6-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Creeping form with sage green foliage. Often used for Bonsai. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus chinensis 'Seagreen' (**Seagreen Juniper**) - Zone 4. 4-6 feet high x 6-8 feet wide. Medium growth rate, about 6-12 inches per year. Full sun or partial shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Rich dark green color. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus communis 'Alpine Carpet' (**Common Juniper, Native Juniper**) - Zone 3. 8 inches high x 3-5 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun, partial or full shade. Dry or moderate soil. Soft blue-green color. A very attractive ground cover. Drought tolerant native.



Juniperus horizontalis 'Blue Chip' (**Blue Chip Juniper**) - Zone 3. 8-10 inches high x 8-10 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, about 1 foot per year. Full sun or partial shade. Dry or moderate soils. Silver-blue color. Forms an attractive, dense mat as a ground cover. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus horizontalis 'Lime Glow' (**Lime Glow Juniper**) - Zone 3. 2 feet high x 8-10 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or part shade. Dry to moderate soil. Bright chartreuse color, for a striking contrast with darker plants. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus horizontalis 'Prince of Wales' (**Prince of Wales Juniper**) - Zone 3. 6-8 inches high x 6-8 feet wide. Slow to medium growing, about 1 foot per year. Full sun or partial shade. Dry or moderate soils. Green with purplish tinge in winter. Forms an attractive, dense mat as a ground cover. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus horizontalis 'Wiltonii' (**Wilton Carpet Juniper, Blue Rug Juniper**) - Zone 3. 4 inches high x 6-8 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, about 1 foot per year. Full sun or partial shade. Dry or moderate soils. Silver-blue foliage and berries. A very low growing ground cover. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus procumbens 'Nana' (**Dwarf Japanese Garden Juniper**) - Zone 4. 1-2 feet high x 4-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry or moderate soil. Gray-green color. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus sabina 'Buffalo' (**Buffalo Juniper**) - Zone 3. 12 inches high x 8 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Full sun or part shade. Dry or moderate soil. Feathery bright green foliage. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus sabina 'Calgary Carpet' (**Calgary Carpet Juniper**) - Zone 3. 6-12 inches high x 6-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or part shade. Dry or moderate soil. Soft green foliage. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus sabina 'Tamariscifolia New Blue' (**New Blue Tam Juniper**) - Zone 3. 18-36 inches high x 10-15 feet wide. Medium growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry to moderate soil. Excellent blue-green foliage. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus scopulorum 'Table Top' (**Table Top Blue Juniper**) - Zone 3. 4-5 feet high x 6-12 feet wide. Slow growth rate, 6 to 12 inches per year. Full sun or part shade. Dry to moderate soil. Silver-blue color. Drought tolerant. NEW FOR 2018



Juniperus squamata 'Blue Star' (**Blue Star Juniper**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Dry or moderate soil. Rich blue color. Very popular for its compact, mounding habit. Not a spreading, groundcover type. Drought tolerant.

JUNIPERUS (JUNIPER) UPRIGHT TYPES:



Juniperus chinensis 'Spartan' (**Spartan Juniper**) - Zone 5. 15-20 feet high x 5-6 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Rich green color. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus chinensis 'Torulosa' (**Hollywood Juniper**) - Zone 5. 15-20 feet high x 10 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Dense, erect, twisted branches have artistic appearance. Rich green foliage. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus communis 'Compressa' (**Compressa Dwarf Common Juniper**) - Zone 4. 3-4 feet high x 1 foot wide. Very slow growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Dry to moderate soil. Dwarf cone-shaped upright. Great for rock gardens. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus communis 'Gold Cone' (**Gold Cone Dwarf Common Juniper**) - Zone 5. 3-5 feet high x 1-2 feet wide. Slow growth rate, 3-6 inches per year. Full sun to part shade. Dry to moderate soil. Dwarf cone-shaped plant. New foliage emerges bright gold. Maintains its color well through summer and fall. Gradually fades to bluish green in winter. Great for rock gardens. Drought tolerant. NEW FOR 2016



Juniperus scopulorum (**Rocky Mountain Juniper, Rocky Mountain Red-Cedar**) - Zone 3. 25-30 feet high x 12-15 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry or moderate soil. Dark green color. Nice symmetrical, pyramidal form. 1/4" bluish 'berries'. Drought tolerant Utah native. The source for 'cedar' fence posts in our area. The 'Jardine Juniper' in Logan Canyon, about 3000 years old, is a Rocky Mountain Juniper.



Juniperus scopulorum 'Gray Gleam' (**Gray Gleam Juniper**) - Zone 3. 15-20 feet high x 6 feet wide. Slow growth rate, 6 to 12 inches per year. Full sun or part shade. Dry or moderate soil. Silvery-gray color. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus scopulorum 'Moonglow' (**Moonglow Juniper**) - Zone 3. 15-20 feet high x 5-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate, 6 to 12 inches per year. Full sun or part shade. Dry to moderate soil. Silver-blue color. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus scopulorum 'Skyrocket' (**Skyrocket Juniper**) - Zone 4. 15 feet high x 2-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate, 6 to 12 inches per year. Full sun to part shade. Dry to moderate soil. Silver-blue color. Drought tolerant.



Juniperus scopulorum 'Wichita Blue' (**Wichita Blue Juniper**) - Zone 3. 15-20 feet high x 5-8 feet wide. Medium growth rate, about 12 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry to moderate soil. Maintains its excellent silver-blue color throughout the year. Drought tolerant.



Kalmia latifolia 'Minuet' (**Minuet Mountain Laurel**) - Zone 4. 2-6 feet high x 2-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full shade to afternoon shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained acid soil. Glossy dark green leaves. Pink buds open to white flowers with a reddish band in late spring to early summer. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Mahonia aquifolium 'Compacta' (**Compact Oregon Grape**) - Zone 5. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growing. Full to part shade, protected area. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Bright yellow flowers in April. Edible bluish berries in late summer. Glossy evergreen leaves. Drought tolerant.



Mahonia repens (**Creeping Oregon Grape**) - Zone 4. 10-16 inches high x 10-16 inches wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Deep yellow flowers in April. Produces edible bluish berries August-September. Leaves are a dull blue-green, turning rich purple to red in winter. Tolerates alkaline soils. Drought tolerant Utah native.



Paxistima canbyi (**Mountain Lover**) - Zone 3. 1 foot high x 3-5 feet wide. Slow growing. Full sun or part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Lustrous dark green leaves turn bronzy green in winter. Tolerate alkaline soils.



Picea abies 'Elegans' (**Elegans Nest Spruce**) - Zone 3. Slow growth rate. Full sun or part shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Low spreading mound shape. Medium green color.



Picea abies 'Formanek' (**Formanek Creeping Norway Spruce**) - Zone 3. 1-2 feet high x 4-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or part shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. A very prostrate green form that will become a dense ground cover over time. Looks good cascading down over rocks or retaining walls.

Picea abies 'Gregoryana Parsonii' (**Gregoryana Parsonii Dwarf Norway Spruce**) - Zone 3.



3-6 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Grows 2-6 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Dark green needles. Rugged, irregular globe shape. With maturity this plant will grow a central leader.



Picea abies 'Little Gem' (**Little Gem Nest Spruce**) - Zone 4. 3 feet high x 3 feet wide. Very slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Dense, uniform globe shape. Tiny, green needles. A great rock garden plant.



Picea abies 'Nidiformis' (**Dwarf Nest Spruce, Bird's Nest Spruce**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 4-5 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. A flat-topped spreading form with light green needles.



Picea abies 'Pumila' (**Dwarf Norway Spruce**) - Zone 2. 3-4 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Broad globe shaped type. Good substitute for Dwarf Nest Spruce. Short, dark green needles.



Picea abies 'Pusch' (**Pusch Dwarf Norway Spruce**) - Zone 3. 3-4 feet high x 4-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Irregularly rounded habit. Produces an abundance of bright purple-red cones in the spring, which become brown as they age. Short, dark green needles. 'Pusch' was named the 'Collector's Conifer of the Year in 2008'.



Picea glauca 'Conica' (**Dwarf Alberta Spruce**) - Zone 2. 5-8 feet high x 2-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 2 to 4 inches per year. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. Susceptible to spider mites, especially in afternoon sun. Popular cone shaped shrub. Fine, grass-green needles.



Picea glauca 'Jean's Dilly' (**Jean's Dilly Dwarf Alberta Spruce**) - Zone 4. 3-6 feet high x 2 feet wide. Very slow growth rate, about 1 inch per year. Full sun or partial shade. Green, upright, narrow plant. A narrower, slower, smaller alternative to 'Dwarf Alberta Spruce.' Susceptible to spider mites, especially in afternoon sun.



Picea glauca 'North Star' (**North Star Dwarf Alberta Spruce**) - Zone 3. 12 feet high x 6 feet wide. Moderate growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. Densely branched, classical pyramid with medium green needles. Very hardy.



Picea glauca 'Sander's Blue' (**Sander's Blue Dwarf Alberta Spruce**) - Zone 4. 5-8 feet high x 2-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. New growth green, older needles slate-blue. Some parts of the plant may revert to green. Susceptible to spider mites, especially in afternoon sun.



Picea glauca 'Yukon Blue' (**Yukon Blue Dwarf Alberta Spruce**) - Zone 3. 5-8 feet high x 2-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. Blue-gray needles, with brown buds at the branch tips. An excellent, hardy blue evergreen.



Picea mariana 'Nana' (**Blue Nest Spruce**) - Zone 2. 1 & 1/2 - 2 feet tall. 2 - 2 & 1/2 feet wide. Very slow growing. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. Dense mound shape with gray-green needles.



Picea omorika 'Nana' (**Dwarf Serbian Spruce**) - Zone 4. 3 feet high x 3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Blue-green needles with white bands on the lower leaf surface.



Picea omorika 'Pimoko' (**Pimoko Dwarf Serbian Spruce**) - Zone 5. 1-2 feet high x 1-2 feet wide. Very slow growth rate, about 1 inch per year. Full sun to afternoon sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Green and silver bicolor needles. Perfect compact globe-shaped shrub for a rock garden.



Picea orientalis 'Shadow's Broom' (**Shadow's Broom Dwarf Oriental Spruce**) - Zone 3. 6-10 feet high x 6-12 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Short, rich green needles. Ascending branch tips. Forms a unique, funnel shaped 'bird's nest' at the center.



Picea pungens 'Glauca Globosa' (**Dwarf Globe Blue Spruce**) - Zone 3. 3-6 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. (Height may differ depending on graft height.) Slow growth rate. Full sun to afternoon sun. Moderate or moist soil. Very popular dwarf shrub with typical blue spruce color. Flat-topped round habit. May be grafted either at ground level or atop a standard at varying heights.



Picea pungens 'Glauca Procumbens' (**Creeping Blue Spruce**) - Zone 2. 1-2 feet high (if not staked up) x 6-10 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, 6-12 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate to moist soil. A nice creeping ground cover type with powder-blue needles. Tips of branches curve upward.



Picea pungens 'R.H. Montgomery' (**Montgomery Globe Blue Spruce**) - Zone 2. 4-8 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 3-6 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate or moist soil. Broad cone shaped globe. Silver-blue needles. Very similar to 'Glauca Globosa'.



Picea pungens 'St. Mary's Broom' (**St. Mary's Broom Globe Blue Spruce**) - Zone 2. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Very slow growing, 1 inch per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate or moist soil. Excellent blue color. Very compact globe shaped shrub.



Picea sitchensis 'Tenas/Papoose' (**Papoose Dwarf Sitka Spruce**) - Zone 5. 4-6 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growing. Grows 1-3 inches per year. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. Bi-colored blue & green needles. Compact, dense, pyramidal shape.



Pinus banksiana 'Schoodic' (**Dwarf Jack Pine**) - Zone 2. 1-2 feet high x 5-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 3 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry soil. Ground hugging plant known for its ability to grow in very poor, sandy soil. Green needles. Drought tolerant.



Pinus banksiana 'Uncle Fogy' (**Uncle Fogy Pine**) - Zone 2. 2 feet high x 10-15 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry soil. Ground hugging plant known for its ability to grow in very poor, sandy soil. Green needles. Drought tolerant.



Pinus contorta 'Spaan's Dwarf' (**Dwarf Lodgepole Pine**) - Zone 5. 3-6 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 3-6 inches per year. Full sun to afternoon sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Very short, dark green, somewhat contorted needles.



Pinus densiflora 'Pendula' (Weeping Japanese Red Pine) - Zone 4. 4-6 feet high x 6-15 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, about 6-12 inches per year. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate soil. Stake to desired height. Weeping branches with green needles that if left unstaked will form a dense creeping mat. Reddish-brown bark.



Pinus leucodermis 'Banderica' (Banderica Dwarf Bosnian Redcone Pine) - Zone 5. 4 feet high x 3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Lush, dark green needles in pairs. A beautiful evergreen shrub with a wide pyramidal habit. Perfect for small spaces. Tolerates alkaline soils. Excellent deer resistance.



Pinus mugo mughus (Mugo Pine, Swiss Mountain Pine) - Zone 3. 6-8 feet high x 12-16 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Large, spreading, multi-stemmed green shrub. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Columnaris' (Columnar Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 2. 8-12 feet high x 5-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate, less than 6 inches per year. Full sun to morning sun. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Narrow upright pine with green needles. Very tough plant. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Jakobsen' (Jakobsen Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 2. 4-5 feet high x 5-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. A spreading, informally globe shaped shrub with long, dark green needles clustered at the ends of its thick branches. The trunk and branches become exposed as the plant ages, giving the look of an ancient bonsai specimen. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Pumilio' (Pumilio Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 3. 3-4 feet high x 4-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Short, rich green needles. This is the most commonly grown Dwarf Mugo. Grown from seed, so habit can be inconsistent. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Sherwood Compact' (Sherwood Compact Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 3. 3-4 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growing, about 3-4 inches per year. Full sun to morning sun. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Short, dark green needles. Mound forming. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Slowmound' (Slowmound Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 3. 3-4 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 3-6 inches per year. Full sun to morning sun. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Forms a dark green, dense mound. Grown from cuttings for a consistent dwarf habit. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Tannenbaum' (Tannenbaum Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 3. 8-12 feet high x 5-6 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, about 6-12 inches per year. Full sun to morning sun. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Compact, pyramidal shape with green needles. Very tough plant. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant.



Pinus mugo 'Wintersonne' (Winter Sun Dwarf Mugo Pine) - Zone 2. 6 feet high x 4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. A beautiful shrub with bright green needles that turn electric yellow in the fall and stay that way through the entire cold season. Provides a bright spark of color in the winter

landscape. Grows well in alkaline soils. Drought tolerant. NEW FOR 2019



Pinus pumila 'Dwarf Blue' (**Dwarf Blue Japanese Stone Pine**) - Zone 3. 2-4 feet high x 6-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 3 inches per year. Full sun to afternoon sun. Moderate soil. Thick, blue needles on a spreading plant. Very unique variety.



Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag' (**Blue Shag Dwarf White Pine**) - Zone 3. 3-6 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 3-6 inches per year. Full sun to morning sun. Moderate to moist soil. Protect from strong winds. Soft blue-green needles make this a very attractive globe-shaped plant.



Pinus strobus 'Mini Twists' (**Mini Twists Dwarf White Pine**) - Zone 3. 6 feet high x 4 feet wide. Slow growth rate, 3-6" per year. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist soil. Thin, bi-color blue and green needles with a unique twist. Protect from strong winds.



Pinus sylvestris 'Glauca Nana' (**Dwarf Scotch Pine**) - Zone 3. 6-8 feet high x 6-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun to afternoon sun. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soils. A dwarf blue-green shrub that forms a broad flattened globe. Drought tolerant.



Pinus sylvestris 'Hillside Creeper' (**Hillside Creeping Scotch Pine**) - Zone 3. 2 feet high x 6-12 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate, about 6-12 inches per year. Full sun to afternoon sun. Dry, moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Creeping pine that creates a nice ground cover. Medium green needles with a slight blue cast. Drought tolerant.



Prunus laurocerasus 'Caucasica Nana' (**Dwarf English Laurel**) - Zone 6. 6 feet high x 6 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Large, thick green leaves. White flowers in May-June. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Prunus laurocerasus 'Otto Luyken' (**Otto Luyken Laurel**) - Zone 6. 2-4 feet high x 4-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade, protected area. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. White flowers in May-June. Shiny, dark green leaves are 4 inches long and 1 inch wide. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Rhododendron 'Nova Zembla' (**Red Rhododendron**) - Zone 4. 4-8 feet high x 4-8 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full shade to afternoon shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained, acid soil. Beautiful dark green evergreen foliage. Red blooms in the spring. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Rhododendron 'Purple Gem' (**Purple Gem Rhododendron**) - Zone 5. 2 feet high x 3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full shade to afternoon shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained, acid soil. Dwarf, dense habit with small green leaves and light purple flowers in the spring. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Rhododendron 'Ramapo' (**Ramapo Rhododendron**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 2-3 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade to full shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained, acid soil. Bright violet-pink flowers from early to mid-spring. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.

Taxus baccata 'Fastigiata' or 'Stricta' (**Irish Yew**) - Zone 5. 15 feet high x 4 feet wide.



Slow growth rate. Full shade or afternoon shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Very densely columnar habit. Dark green needles. All plant parts are poisonous, if eaten. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Taxus baccata 'Repandens' (**Dwarf Spreading English Yew**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 8-12 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade or full shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Dark green needles. Dwarf, wide spreading form. Produces red berries. All plant parts are poisonous, if eaten. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Taxus x media 'Dark Green Spreader' (**Dark Green Spreading Yew**) - Zone 4. 3 feet high x 4-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade or full shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Compact, spreading habit. Dark green needles. All plant parts are poisonous, if eaten. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Taxus x media 'Densiformis' (**Dense Yew**) - Zone 4. 3-4 feet high x 4-6 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade or full shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Dense, spreading plant with bright green needles. All plant parts are poisonous, if eaten. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



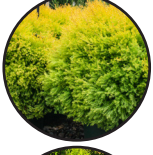
Taxus x media 'Hicksii' (**Hicks Yew**) - Zone 4. 10-15 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Afternoon shade or full shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Attractive upright grower with dark green needles. May produce red berries. All plant parts are poisonous, if eaten. * We recommend planting close to your house on the north or east side.



Thuja occidentalis 'Degroot's Spire' (**Degroot's Spire Arborvitae**) - Zone 3. 8-12 feet high x 2-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate, about 6 inches per year. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Extra narrow columnar habit. Dark green. Grows well in alkaline soil.



Thuja occidentalis 'Emerald' ('Smaragd') (**Emerald Arborvitae**) - Zone 3. 10-15 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Bright emerald green foliage that doesn't discolor in winter. Great for screening and hedging. Grows well in alkaline soil.



Thuja occidentalis 'Rheingold' (**Rheingold Arborvitae**) - Zone 3. 4-5 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Deep, rich gold foliage that turns copper to brown in winter.



Thuja orientalis 'Aurea Nana' (**Berkman's Golden Arborvitae**) - Zone 5. 5-10 feet high x 3-6 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Foliage golden yellow to pale yellow-green. Grows well in alkaline soil.



Thuja plicata 'Spring Grove' (**Spring Grove Giant Arborvitae, Western Red Cedar**) - Zone 5. 20-30 feet high x 10-12 feet wide. Fast growing. Full sun to partial shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Rich green color that holds well in winter. Pyramidal habit. Makes a great fast growing privacy screen or hedgerow. Not favored by deer. A Proven Winners color Choice variety.



Thuja plicata 'Whipcord' (**Whipcord Arborvitae**) - Zone 5. 4-6 feet high x 3-5 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate or moist, well-drained soil. Thick, narrow green leaves with sharp points. Ivory white flowers on 3-6 foot spikes in summer. Drought tolerant.



Yucca filamentosa (**Adam's Needle Yucca**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry or moderate soil. Thick, narrow green leaves with sharp points. Ivory white flowers on 3 to 6 foot spikes in summer. Drought tolerant.



Yucca filamentosa 'Golden Sword' (**Golden Sword Yucca**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry or moderate soil. Ivory white flowers on 3 to 6 foot spikes in summer. Narrow green leaves with yellow center and sharp points. Drought tolerant.



Yucca filamentosa 'Ivory Tower' (**Ivory Tower Yucca**) - Zone 4. 3-4 feet high x 3-5 feet wide. Slow growth rate. Full sun to afternoon sun. Dry to moderate soil. Long sword-like green leaves with sharp points. Tall spikes of ivory white blooms, up to 6 feet high, in the spring. Drought tolerant.



Yucca glauca (**Soapweed Yucca**) - Zone 4. 2-3 feet high x 3-4 feet wide. Slow to medium growth rate. Full sun or afternoon sun. Dry or moderate soil. Greenish white flowers on 3 to 4 & 1/2 foot spikes in July-August. Narrow leaves with bluish-green color. Drought tolerant.
