

# VINES



*Akebia quinata* (**Fiveleaf Akebia**) - Zone 4. 20'-30' h. Medium to fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Dry, moderate, or moist soil. Vigorous twining vine with blue-green leaves. Small fragrant chocolate-purple flowers bloom in spring, but are often hidden among the leaves. Can be used on trellises and other similar structures. Purplish 2 & 1/4 to 4" long sausage-shaped fruits are produced in late summer to fall, supposed to be edible. See Dirr page 81.



*Ampelopsis brevipedunculata* (**Porcelain Vine**) - Zone 4. 10'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. (Best fruiting occurs in full sun.) Any soil that is not permanently wet. 2 & 1/2 - 5" green leaves and very showy berries that start greenish-ivory, turning to pale lilac and finally to bright blue, providing excellent fall color. Should be given ample support for climbing. Clings by tendrils.



*Ampelopsis brevipedunculata* 'Elegans' (**Variegated Porcelain Vine**) - Zone 4. 10'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. (Best fruiting occurs in full sun.) Any soil that is not permanently wet. Variegated pink, green, and white new leaves. Very showy berries that start greenish-ivory, turning to pale lilac and finally to bright blue providing excellent fall color. Should be given ample support for climbing. Clings by tendrils.



*Campsis radicans* (**Trumpet Vine**) - Zone 4. 30'-40' h. Very fast growth rate. Full sun. Dry, moderate, or moist soil. Orange trumpet shaped flowers in late summer. Usually leafs out late, so be patient. Easy to grow, hard to kill. Clings by root-like holdfasts. Drought tolerant.



*Campsis radicans* 'Flava' (**Yellow Trumpet Vine**) - Zone 4. 30'-40' h. Very fast growth rate. Full sun. Dry, moderate, or moist soil. Yellow trumpet shaped flowers in late summer. Usually leafs out late, so be patient. Easy to grow, hard to kill. Clings by root-like holdfasts. Drought tolerant.



*Campsis radicans* 'Judy' (**Judy Yellow Trumpet Vine**) - Zone 4. 30'-40' h. Very fast growth rate. Full sun. Dry, moderate, or moist soil. Beautiful, bright yellow trumpet shaped flowers in late summer. Usually leafs out late, so be patient. Easy to grow, hard to kill. Clings by root-like holdfasts. Drought tolerant.



*Campsis x tagliabuana* 'Summer Jazz Fire' (**Summer Jazz Fire Dwarf Trumpet Vine**) - Zone 4. 3-4' h. x 4-5' w. Moderate to fast growth rate. Full sun. Dry, moderate, or moist soil. Flame red trumpet shaped flowers with intense orange overtones from spring to frost. Half the size of other trumpet vines. Usually leafs out late, so be patient. Easy to grow, hard to kill. Clinging vine. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies. Drought tolerant. NEW FOR 2018



*Clematis* - Zone 4. 5'-20' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun or partial shade. Moderate, well-drained soil. Flowers from summer to fall. Flowers and leaves like sunlight and roots like shade. To accomplish this, plant in sun or partial sun and mulch with a 3 inch layer of shredded bark to keep the root zone cool.

Blue Ravine - Large 7-8" flowers. Lilac blue suffused with pinkish mauve.



Elsa Spath - Rich lavender blue flowers with reddish-purple anthers.



Ernest Markham - Three to four inch red-violet flowers with gold anthers.



Hagley Hybrid - Shell pink flowers.



Henry - Large 4 to 5" white flowers with dark anthers.



Jackmani - Rich violet-purple 5" flowers.



John Warren - 6-8" flowers. French gray flowers with dark red center bar and edges on petals. Red anthers.



Josephine - Double pink flowers.



Lilacina Floribunda - Deep rich purple flowers.



Lord Neville - Large purple flowers in summer.



Mine Edouarde Andre - Crimson with yellow anthers.



Montana Rubens - Varies from light pink to deep rose-pink. Purplish leaves. Vanilla fragrance.



Nelly Moser - Pale mauve-pink flower with a deep pink bar in the center of each petal.



Nobe - Dark red flowers with golden anthers.



Proteus -Double, semi double, and single flowers. Soft mauve-pink.



Ramona - Clear blue, dark centered flowers.



Royalty - 5-6" double to semi-double dark purple flowers with yellow anthers.



Star of India - Reddish plum with a red bar in the center of each petal.



Sugar Candy - 6-7" flowers. Pinkish mauve petals with darker center bar. Yellow anthers.



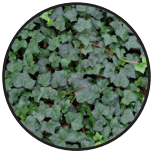
Sunset - 5-7" dark velvet-red flowers with purple edges.



Ville Delyon - Red blooms with golden anthers in summer. Velvety appearance.



Vitcella Venosa Violacea - 4-5" flowers. White background with purple veins throughout, turning all purple on the edges.



*Hedera helix* (**English Ivy**) - Zone 5. 6-18" tall as ground cover, 10'-30' as a vine. Fast growth rate after roots are well established. Partial shade to full shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Tolerates alkaline soils well. Dark green leaves. A true clinging vine. Evergreen.



*H. h.* 'Thorndale' (**Thorndale Ivy**) - Zone 5. 6-18" tall as ground cover, 10'-30' as a vine. Fast growth rate after roots are well established. Partial shade to full shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Tolerates alkaline soils well. Larger dark green leaves with creamy white veins. Red winter color. A true clinging vine. Evergreen.



*Hydrangea anomala petiolaris* (**Climbing Hydrangea**) - Zone 4. 40'-60' h. Slow growing until established then grows fast. Partial shade to full shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. True clinging vine that requires adequate support as it will become quite heavy. Striking white flower clusters in summer. Glossy dark green leaves turn yellow in fall.



*Lonicera crassifolia* 'Ruatzam' (**Runalong Creeping Honeysuckle**) - Zone 5. 2-4 inches high x 3 feet wide. Slow growing. Full sun to part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soils. A very low growing evergreen groundcover with small dark green shiny leaves. Clusters of highly fragrant, miniature creamy yellow flowers with red throats.



*Lonicera japonica* 'Aureoreticulata' (**Variegated Honeysuckle Vine**) - Zone 4. 15'-30' h. Full sun to part shade, best in full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Very attractive, yellow variegated leaves. Twining vine.



*Lonicera japonica* 'Halliana' (**Hall's Honeysuckle**) - Zone 4. 15'-30' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soils. Fragrant white flowers turning to yellow from June through November. Twining vine.



*Lonicera japonica* 'Purpurea' (**Purple Leaf Honeysuckle**) - Zone 5. 10'-20' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soils. Dark green leaves with purplish tint. Purple-red flowers with white insides and coral-red berries. Twining vine.



*Lonicera periclyclenum* 'Peaches & Cream' (**Peaches & Cream Honeysuckle**) - Zone 4. 5-6' h x 2-5' w. Moderate growth rate. Full sun to partial shade. Dry to moist, well-drained soil. Deep magenta buds open to fragrant white, pink, and magenta flowers that mature to a peachy cream color. Beautiful compact twining vine that can be used on a trellis or fence. Drought and heat tolerant. Evergreen in mild winters.



*Lonicera periclyclenum* 'Scentsation' (**Scentsation Honeysuckle**) - Zone 4. 10-12' h x 5' w. Fast growth rate. Full sun to partial shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Possibly the most fragrant honeysuckle. Showy bright yellow flowers. Beautiful twining vine that can be used on a trellis or fence, or as a ground cover. A Proven Winners Color Choice Variety.



*Lonicera x heckrottii* 'Goldflame' (**Goldflame Honeysuckle**) - Zone 4. 10-20' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Slightly fragrant red blooms with yellow corollas inside throughout the summer. Twining vine.



*Lonicera x* 'Mandarin' (**Mandarin Honeysuckle**) - Zone 4. 15-20' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Mandarin orange flowers with yellow interiors from early summer through fall. Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.

Glossy, deep green leaves. Disease resistant. Twining vine.



*Parthenocissus quinquefolia* (**Virginia Creeper**) - Zone 4. 30'-50' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Tolerates any soil condition. Clinging vine with tendrils. Will climb or crawl along the ground. Very attractive red fall color and black berries.



*Parthenocissus tricuspidata* 'Green Showers' (**Green Showers Boston Ivy**) - Zone 4. 30-50' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Dry, moderate or moist soil. True clinging vine with big green leaves turning burgundy red in fall. Blue berries in fall.



*Parthenocissus tricuspidata* 'Veitchii' (**Boston Ivy**) - Zone 4. 30'-40' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Dry, moderate or moist soil. Clinging vine with small maple-like leaves. Leaves turn brilliant orange-red in fall. Great for covering a wall.



*Polygonum aubertii* (**Silver Lace Vine**) - Zone 4. 25'-35' h. Very fast growth rate. Full sun to full shade. Dry to moderate soil. White fragrant flowers in late summer. Twining vine. Drought tolerant.



*Vitis vinifera purpurea* (**Purple Leafed Grape**) - Zone 5. 30' to 100' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun or part shade. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Attractive purple-leaved twining vine. Small to medium fruits produced in early fall.



*Wisteria floribunda* 'Honbeni' (**Pink Ice Japanese Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 20'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Blooms in May. 12-16" soft pink flower clusters tinged with lavender. Twining vine. Japanese wisterias twine clockwise. Drought tolerant.



*Wisteria floribunda* 'Longissima Alba' (**White Japanese Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 20'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Blooms in May. White flower clusters. Clockwise twining vine. Drought tolerant.



*Wisteria floribunda* 'Rosea' (**Pink Japanese Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 20'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Blooms in May. Pale rose, tipped with purple, fragrant flower clusters up to 18 inches long. Clockwise twining vine. Drought tolerant.



*Wisteria floribunda* 'Texas Purple' (**Purple Japanese Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 20'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Blooms in May. Violet purple flower clusters. Clockwise twining vine. Drought tolerant.



*Wisteria frutescens* 'Amethyst Falls' (**Amethyst Falls American Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 20'-25' h. Fast growth rate. Full Sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Beautiful fragrant lavender blue flowers in 4-6 inch clusters. Blooms much later than other wisterias: starts in late spring and repeats blooming through mid-summer on current year's growth. A twining vine that is native to the Eastern U.S., where it is usually found in moist or swampy areas.



*Wisteria macrostachys* 'Aunt Dee' (**Aunt Dee Kentucky Wisteria**) - Zone 4. 15'-25' h. Moderate growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Tolerates wet soils better than the Asian Wisteria varieties. Blooms in late spring and early summer. 8-12" light lilac-purple flower clusters. Twining vine.



Wisteria macrostachys 'Blue Moon' (**Blue Moon Wisteria**) - Zone 4. 15'-25' h. Moderate growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Tolerates wet soils better than the Asian Wisteria varieties. Blooms in late spring and early summer. 8-12" deep lavender blue flower clusters. Twining vine.



Wisteria sinensis (**Chinese Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 25-30' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Slightly fragrant blue-violet flowers on 6-12 inch clusters. Twining vine - Chinese wisterias twine counter-clockwise.



Wisteria sinensis 'Blue' (**Blue Chinese Wisteria - Treeform**) - Zone 5. 6-8 feet high x 8-10 feet wide. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Violet blue flowers on 8 to 20 inch long stems in April-May. Tree wisterias require staking when young.



Wisteria sinensis 'Pink' (**Pink Chinese Wisteria - Treeform**) - Zone 5. 6-8 feet high x 8-10 feet wide. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Pink flowers on 8 to 20 inch long stems in April-May. Tree Wisterias require staking when young.



Wisteria sinensis 'Prolific' (**Blue Chinese Wisteria - Treeform**) - Zone 5. 6-8 feet high x 8-10 feet wide. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Blue-violet flowers on 8-20 inch long stems in April-May. Tree Wisterias require staking when young.



Wisteria sinensis 'Prolific' (**Prolific Chinese Wisteria**) - Zone 5. 25-30' h. Fast growth rate. Full sun. Moderate to moist, well-drained soil. Slightly fragrant blue-violet flowers on 6 to 12 inch clusters. Twining vine - Chinese wisterias twine counter-clockwise.
