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Policies & Procedures:

By signing this registration form, I am agreeing to the following policies & procedures.

Arrival for Lessons

- Swimmers must come to their lesson no earlier than 5 minutes before the lesson starts <u>and</u> swimmers must come already dressed. Changing rooms will only be available for changing <u>after</u> the lesson.
- The swimmer must be signed in immediately upon arrival with our deck supervisor.
- Anything worn in the pool <u>must</u> be made of bathing suit material. Street clothes (e.g., t-shirts or basketball shorts) will not be allowed in the pool as the material affects water clarity.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.

COVID-19 Policies

- Please <u>notify</u> us of any exposures or illnesses prior to your lesson. Since policies and
 recommendations may change, we will let you know of current policies in place at the time of your
 exposure or illness. Your lesson may be credited to your account if we are notified in advanced and
 determine it is cancelled due to a COVID-19 related illness.
- No swimmers should attend lessons with symptoms of the coronavirus.
- Please stay up to date on our mask policies. We may require masking on deck during peaks in illness.

Other Illness Policies

• In addition to the symptoms of COVID-19, please do not bring your child to lessons if your child has any gastrointestinal issues in the past 24 hours. This is to ensure the health and safety of all swimmers.

Deck Policies

- Only 1 guardian per child will be allowed into the facility and remain at Westfield during your child's
 entire lesson. You may not drop off and leave your child unattended during a lesson. You are welcome
 to wait at a table on deck or wait in your car but at no time should you leave the facility without your
 child. You are expected to return to the pool deck 5 minutes prior to the swimmer's lesson ending.
- Do <u>NOT</u> allow your child in the water at any point without the supervision of lifeguard. Please have them wait at the tables.
- To minimize distraction for the swimmers and maintain a safe environment, we ask that spectators remain
 quietly seated while in the pool area.
- If you would like to take pictures or videos, please make sure it is ONLY your child, and not any other children or instructors.
- Please do your best to clean up after yourself and your children.
- Once lessons have been completed and you have changed, please exit promptly through the door by the changing stations.

Parking

Parking or drop offs will not be allowed in the circular loop outside of the pool or in bus parking in front of
the building. The loop is actively used and monitored for childcare drop off and pickup. To park in the
back lot, you should enter through the Pearl Street entrance. Cars existing the center must exit through
the Torrey Street exit only.
