NOTES on wood: Almost any walnut checkers well, American black walnut, West coast English walnut, Bastone and probably the best is Turkish Circassian Walnut.

But please; no Maple. After 20 years and hundreds of maple stocks, very few checkered well. The figured maple, birds eye, and tiger strip maple are very soft and I finally made the decision to not checker maple any more.
