Select a **Date**

Select a date and time to harvest your potatoes.

October 12th, October 13th, or October 14th

Please let Bianca know your day and time you plan to harvest.

We suggest to go out as a grade level.

Home **Project**

Have students create their own "Potato People" with their family. Copy attached sheet and send home to the parents on October 11th.

Send home October 11th **Due October 15th**

"Potato People" are due by **October 15th**. Potato People will be displayed on the Library Shelves until **October 22nd**.

Day of harvesting

Pick up trowels and baskets from Bianca.

Go your potato bed from last year.
Grade 1 - Harvests the Kindergarten beds
Grade 2 - Harvests the Grade 1 beds
Grade 3 - Harvests the Grade 2Yeager bed
Kindergarten E - Harvests the Krom Bed
Kindergarten C - Harvests the Conrad Bed
Grade 4 - Harvests the Carney Bed

* Please consider parent volunteers as needed.

Have the students gently remove the hay from their bed.

Right under the straw will be seed potatoes. Harvest the remaining potatoes using trowel.

Straw and vines to compost pile by Grade 4 working w/ Mrs. McBride

Bring potatoes inside the classroom count and sort the potatoes. Card board pizza boxes (donated by Speak Easy) will be supplied.

Do not wash.

Turn your Potato Facts sheet to Patti G.


Place your potatoes in the kitchen.
