

Star Power Snake Plant (Sansevieria 'Star Power')



Quick Care Guide

- **Light:** Low to bright indirect light; tolerates full sun but variegation shines in moderate light.
- **Water:** Water sparingly—every 2–4 weeks when soil is fully dry. Overwatering causes rot.
- **Soil:** Sandy, well-draining mix; cactus soil works well.
- **Temperature:** 70–90°F; hardy down to 50°F.
- **Care Tips:** Wipe leaves to keep them dust-free; slow-growing, low maintenance.

Bioactive Enclosure Use

- **Best For:** Arid setups (e.g., sulcatas, bearded dragons).
- **Placement:** Upright in corners or as a focal point; roots anchor in drier substrate zones.
- **Benefits:** Safe in moderation if tortoises nibble; tough leaves withstand dry conditions. Adds vertical interest to bioactive enclosures with minimal water needs, pairing well with your substrate if kept less moist.
- **Tip:** Surround with rocks to deter digging; cleanup crews thrive beneath its base.
