

## Variegated Spider Plant (*Chlorophytum comosum* 'Variegatum')



### Quick Care Guide

- **Light:** Bright, indirect light; adapts to low light but variegation may dull. Avoid harsh sun.
- **Water:** Water when top inch of soil dries; drought-tolerant but prefers consistent moisture.
- **Soil:** Loose, well-draining mix; not picky.
- **Temperature:** 60–90°F; keep above 50°F.
- **Care Tips:** Remove brown tips if they appear; pups can be propagated easily.

### Bioactive Enclosure Use

- **Best For:** Versatile—humid or semi-arid setups (e.g., Russian tortoises, lizards).
- **Placement:** Elevated pots or hanging; cascading pups add depth. Can root into substrate.
- **Benefits:** Non-toxic for tortoises; air-purifying qualities benefit enclosed spaces. Hardy in bioactive setups, coexisting with isopods and your coir/moss mix.
- **Tip:** Use as a “filler” plant; its resilience handles varying humidity levels.
