





Lost Heritage Productions


The Teachers App, developed by supported by our partner **Bharti Airtel Foundation**, is designed to “help teachers uplift their schools.”

- Celebrate diversity, values, and the spirit of giving.


Retreats in the Calendar Year




Special Projects

Arthur Foot Academy (AFA), a small village school near Rajaji National Park, has been one of the most inspiring journeys within the Good Schools Alliance. With classes up to Grade 6, the school reflects how collaboration, community support, and the Joy of Giving can transform education in underserved areas.

- **Infrastructure:** With DSOBS support, AFA set up a Digital Community Center with WiFi, laptop, monitor, and screen.
- **Retreats:** Hosted two editions of the My Good School Retreat, helping students experience “Bridging Two Indias.”
- **Teacher Development:** Ongoing training and mentoring through the Teachers Academy.
- **Equity:** All support provided at **no cost to the school**, ensuring sustainability and inclusion.



