The My Good School program aims at altering the environment by empowering students and focussing on personal and social development with the help of different stakeholders, namely, teachers, management and the community at large





The word green is closely related to the Old English verb growan, "to grow". **Individuals** must develop skills for life.


## The prestigious blue for Study.

## **College Readiness**


