The Shelter and Mental Health Learning Event will identify opportunities for the Shelter and Settlements sector to do more and do better with respect to mental health, helping to support the emergency, transitional and recovery plans and priorities of people affected by crisis.

The Learning Event is hosted by **Oxford Brookes University's Centre for Development and Emergency Practice (CENDEP)** and **CARE International UK**. We will be joined by speakers from the **Norwegian Refugee Council**, **Catholic Relief Services**, the **International Organization for Migration** and practitioners and academics from the fields of humanitarian shelter, protection, health and development.

Thursday 20TH MAY 1400 – 1700 BST

Information sharing and advocacy sessions will explore the multiple intersections between humanitarian shelter and mental health, using lessons and case studies from the field as a springboard for discussion.

Friday 28th May 1000 – 1300 BST

Entry points for incorporating mental health considerations into programming will be explored through case studies and will prompt sharing of priorities and practical ideas around assessments, implementation and monitoring/evaluation. Small group discussions will be moderated by experienced practitioners.
