EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT COST BEGINS AT \$2000

EQUIPMENT USE:

DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN OR ADULTS ACTING LIKE CHILDREN UNATTENDED

APPLE CRUSHER:

1. Turn the red knob clockwise until it pops out. This knob is your shut-off button.
2. Turn the power on using the white switch located above the red button.
3. **Make sure the crusher is running BEFORE you put apples in.**
4. Put apples into the crusher gradually. If you dump in an entire bucket of apples, the blades will jam and you will cause damage to the motor and blow your breaker.
5. The blades on the crusher are VERY SHARP. Do not put any body part down the chute.

Always unplug the crusher before cleaning, assembling or disassembling.

BLADDER PRESS:

1. Place lid on drum making sure it is seated flat within the drum and tighten.
2. Turn the drain valve off by turning the lever perpendicular to the faucet.
3. Open the top bladder valve located on the top of the press by holding down the button.
4. Turn on water supply.
5. When water begins to squirt out through the top bladder valve, close the valve (let go of the button). This ensures the bladder is completely full of water and there is no air in the bladder.
6. Turn off water supply.
7. Open the drain valve by turning the lever parallel to the faucet. Allow bladder to drain. This flattens the bladder and gives you more room for fruit.
8. Turn the drain valve off.
9. Carefully loosen and remove the lid.
10. For easier cleaning, line the inside of the drum with the mesh lining and drape the excess over the top.
11. Pour fruit into the perforated drum until it is 2/3 full. DO NOT REST BUCKETS/CONTAINERS ON THE DRUM WHEN FILLING - IT WILL TIP OVER AND YOU WILL MAKE A MESS!
12. Place lid on drum making sure it is seated flat within the drum.
13. Place washer on top of lid and tighten handle on top of the washer. Turn on the water supply.
14. If/when water begins to spray from the relief valve, reduce the water supply until only a trickle of water comes out of the relief valve. This just saves water.
15. Once pressing is complete, turn off the water supply and open the drain at the bottom by turning the lever so it is parallel with the faucet. (CONTINUED ON NEXT PAGE)

16. DO NOT UNSCREW/REMOVE THE LID UNTIL YOU CAN PEER THROUGH THE DRUM AND SEE DAYLIGHT ON THE OTHER SIDE. Remember, you just had the bladder full of water and it is pressed against the side and lid of the drum.
17. Empty the pressed fruit and repeat steps 10-15.

STEMMER CRUSHER:

1. Make sure lid covering paddles is on.
2. Place a container at the end to catch stems.
3. Place a container below the chute to catch grapes/juice.
4. Turn power on.
5. Pour fruit into top.
6. KEEP ALL BODY PARTS OUT OF THE STEMMER CRUSHER.

Turn off the power and unplug the equipment before cleaning, assembling or disassembling.

HOW TO CLEAN THE EQUIPMENT (AND AVOID LOSING YOUR \$50 DEPOSIT):

TURN OFF AND UNPLUG EQUIPMENT BEFORE CLEANING.

BLADDER PRESS:

1. Lift the drum from off the base.
2. Do not remove the bladder from the base.
3. Hose off all parts and reassemble.

APPLE CRUSHER:

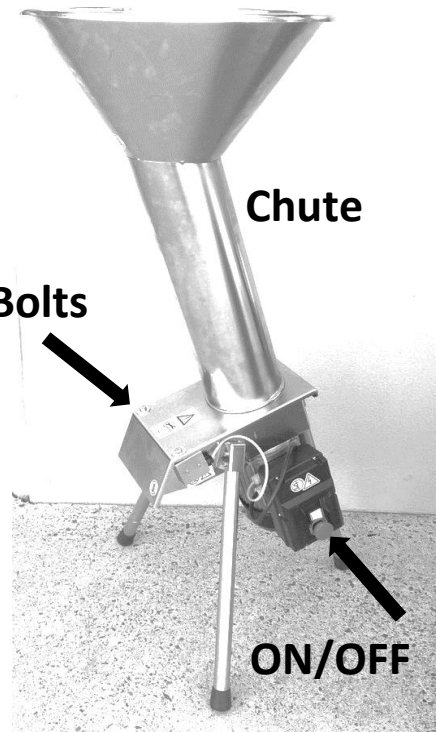
1. Unplug power source.
2. Remove top by unscrewing the two bolts. Do not lose the bolts!
3. Remove the screen located in front of the blades by pulling upward forcefully.
4. Clean all parts taking care to keep water away from the motor.
5. Reassemble and make sure the bolt with the nipple is placed on the right.

USE CAUTION AROUND THE BLADES – THEY ARE SHARP.

STEMMER CRUSHER:

1. Unplug power source.
2. Remove lid covering paddles.
3. Remove the cage surrounding the paddles by pulling straight out forcefully.
4. Hose off and clean all parts and reassemble.
