Here is a fun contest for your 1st, 2nd or 3rd grade students! The Gig Harbor Peninsula Arbor Day Organization, a local 501(c)(3) non-profit foundation, is sponsoring an essay/art contest to raise student awareness about the importance of trees to our world. Entries must be received by April 4th, 2019.

Theme: "Why Trees Are Important"

- Open to all students from the Peninsula School District or private schools in Gig Harbor currently enrolled in first through third grades.
- Students should clearly print or write 3 to 4 sentences using the entry form provided, which may be copied or downloaded from our website.
- Entry must include a colored drawing that illustrates the essay.
- Essays will be judged on originality, content, spelling, grammar and punctuation. Drawings will be judged on creativity and execution. Equal weight given to each.
- Essay/art entries must be received by April 4th. Name, grade, teacher, and student's school should be clearly
 printed on each entry form. Winners will be notified by April 12th. A list of winners will also be posted on our
 website: www.gigharborarbor.org.
- A \$25 gift certificate to Teaching Toys Too in Uptown, Gig Harbor will be awarded to the winning student AND teacher in each grade: 1st, 2nd and 3rd. A public awards presentation will take place between 11:30 am and 12:30 pm.
- Entries can be sent through the district pony to "PHS Main Office c/o Arbor Day", hand delivered to the
 Peninsula High School main office labeled "Arbor Day Contest" or mailed to: Arbor Day at 621 Pacific Ave Suite
 216, Tacoma WA 98402. If going through the district pony allow an extra 2 days or regular mail 3 days before
 the contest due date!
