The 2nd Place winner and teacher will each receive \$50 and 3rd Place will receive \$25 each. The purpose of this contest is to raise awareness about the importance of trees to the earth and all living things. Thank you for participating!

## **CONTEST RULES:**

- 1. All entries must be original and created by fourth or fifth grade students in the Gig Harbor/Key Peninsula areas. Posters must be complete and in color. Only one entry per student please! All posters will be displayed during the event and artwork will be returned to the students.
- 2. The poster should send a simple, but positive visual message about the benefits of trees.
- 3. Entries may be done in marker, crayon, watercolor, ink, acrylic or poster paint. Keep in mind that bolder images make more impact and reproduce more successfully. The art paper should be no smaller than 8 ½" x 11" nor larger than 11" x 17". Computer generated art or collages are not accepted. Do not fold entries!
- 4. Entries can be sent through the district pony to "PHS Main Office c/o Arbor Day", hand delivered to the Peninsula High School main office labeled "Arbor Day Contest" or mailed to: Arbor Day at 621 Pacific Ave Suite 216, Tacoma WA 98402. If going through the district pony allow an extra 2 days or regular mail 3 days before the contest due date!
- 5. All entries must be received by March 27th. Winners will be notified by April 4th and invited to receive their prizes in person at 11:30 during the public "Arbor Day Celebration" at the Civic Center. Winners will also be posted on our website.
- 6. Entry in the contest implies consent to reproduce artwork in advertising and on our website.
