- **A Thriller Flash Mob** featuring a local high school dance team
- **STEM Nola** providing interactive STEM demonstrations
- Over a dozen **Carnival Games with Youth and Adult Prizes**, and will close out with
- “**Dancing in the Streets**” featuring celebrity **DJ Arie Spins**

Marchand says his is extremely proud of how community stakeholders have stepped up to make the event possible: “Some political leaders haven’t even responded to our requests, but the organizations in our community have shown their commitment and dedication to our residents.”
