General Manager Allen informed the Board the official water report has not been released by TCEQ. The District has pumped 11,499 ac/ft and sold 14,439 ac/ft as of February 2023. We also pumped 24 hours of no charge watet at 160 cfs. He calculates the District's useable balance as of 3/15/2023 to be 77,705 ac/ft, not including contract water. This balance should cover the District through the end of March and part of April, commencing allocation at some point in April 2023.
