Item #8.1: Water Update

General Manager Allen informed the Board the District has pumped 28,138 ac/ft and sold 28,778 ac/ft as of May 2023. The District's useable balance is 78,150 ac/ft and the storage balance is 78,150 ac/ft. The District was allocated 6,089 ac/ft this period. The District has pumped 1,197 ac/ft of no-charge water for this period. He anticipates going into allocation in August 2023.

Item #8.2: Service truck update

General Manager Allen informed the Board he is having a difficult time getting a repair shop to fix the frame of the service truck. The truck is longer than the typical vehicle and their equipment if not equipped for such lengths. The insurance carrier informed they will cover expenses if a repair shop out of the Rio Grande Valley is hired for the job.
