
Our Mission




Professional Contribution Award

At this time we are calling for nominations for the 2023 Professional Contribution Award. Nominations will be accepted until August 25th, 2023. Please submit your nomination via email to the Vice President, Heather Hannaford (Heather.Hannaford@albertahealthservices.ca.)

Eligibility:

- Nominees should have a minimum of ten(10) years in the field of Radiological Sciences and Imaging, except under extraordinary circumstances;
- ii) Must have served on the executive or a committee for the AARM;
- iii) Must have been a member of the AARM for a minimum of five (5) years; and
- iv) No currently active committee member shall be eligible for nomination.
