

Let Me Ask You

Number of players: Two or more

Age group: 7 years and up

Equipment needed: None

Indoor Outdoor



Players take turns asking the player to their right, a question. That player must reply with a question – NOT A STATEMENT. The two continue their round of questions until one of them accidentally answers with a statement, and they are out. The winner of that round then begins a new round with the player on their right, in the same manner.

Each player must respond within five seconds, responses must make sense to the question asked, and responses may not be repeated.

EXAMPLE:

ROUND ONE

Player 1: *What is your name?*

Player 2: *Why would you ask me that?*

Player 1: *You don't know why?*

Player 2: *Am I supposed to know?*

Player 1: *Of course you are!* (Player 1 is out because this isn't a question)

ROUND TWO

Player 2: *How are you feeling today?*

Player 3: *Why, do I look sick?*

Player 2: *Yes you do.* (Player 2 is out)

ROUND THREE

Player 3: *Is it supposed to rain today?*

Player 4: *Do I look like a meteorologist?*

Player 3: *Do meteorologists look goofy?*

Player 4: *What do you mean by "goofy"?*

Player 3: *Are you serious?*

Player 4: *Would I ask if I wasn't serious?*

Player 3: *No, I suppose not.* (Player 3 is out)
