

DUCKPIN BOWLING FAQS

01

WHAT IS DUCKPIN BOWLING?

It's a game similar to regular bowling, with a few twists (keep reading!), but the objective is the same: knock down as many pins as possible.

02

WHO GOES FIRST?

The oldest player in the group gets to go first (because we respect our elders). If no one wants to reveal their age, flip a coin (it's not polite to ask a lady her age, after all). Tell us your bowling order and names when you check in upon arrival. Nicknames are not only allowed, but encouraged (extra points for making us laugh).

WHERE DO YOU STAND?

You stand on the floor behind the raised lanes. You may not step up onto the lanes themselves. We repeat, please do not step up on to the lanes! They are slippery and you're not supposed to walk on them; placing your foot up on the lane is a penalty (just like crossing the foul line in regular bowling).

04

DO I HAVE TO WEAR BOWLING SHOES?

No, you can wear your regular shoes! Since you're not walking on the slippery lanes (see FAQ #3) you can wear whatever shoes you're comfortable in. No rental shoes ruining your outfit here!

05

DO YOU USE REGULAR BOWLING BALLS?

No, the balls for Duckpin Bowling are lighter and smaller than a regular bowling ball and there are no holes to put your fingers in. Perfect for little kids or anyone who has a hard time rolling a traditional bowling ball.

06

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU KNOCK DOWN ALL OF YOUR PINS AT ONE TIME?

Strike! Just like in regular bowling, you get a strike and everyone has to high five you!

No one has EVER bowled a 300 in Duckpin Bowling. Bowl a perfect game and you better come up to the front for a picture!
